Sometimes, people are able to hide their true or who they are on the inside, but God makes it so that the people are obviously tainted, even to a nation like Babylon
As a result of their guilt, God says they will be taken in hand, but in order for a people to be taken, their must first fall
Zedekiah is the king at the time, so he must remove his crown and turban, until the time when the comes to restore the house of David
The conclusion seems: that the end will come for the Judeans and/or the Ammonites, as the blade is raised above the neck, just like before an execution
However, very, God says to put the sword away and with it, the menacing brandishing that was going on, discarding Babylon as His chosen instrument
In Chapter 22, God uses the "the bloody city" for Jerusalem, because they have earned the nickname just as much as the Assyrian city of Nineveh that Jonah despised
Nicknames come as a result of repeated, based on features, personality, or conduct, which leads us to believe violence had become part of the fabric of God's people
