A STATEMENT OF OUR PRACTICE OF CLOSE COMMUNION

The Lord's Supper is celebrated at this congregation in the confession and glad confidence that, as He says, Our Lord gives into our mouths not only bread and wine but His very Body and Blood to eat and to drink for the forgiveness of sins. I Cor. 10:14ff. Our Lord invites to His table those who repent of all their sins and who trust His words, that they may show forth His death until He comes. Because those who eat and drink our Lord's Body and Blood unworthily do so to their great harm (I Cor 11:29) and because Holy Communion is a confession of faith which is confessed at this altar, (I Cor. 10:15-18) any who are **not yet instructed in this faith, who in doubt, or who hold a confession differing from that of this congregation and the Lutheran Church Missouri-Synod, and yet desire to receive the Sacrament, are asked to speak with one of the Pastors in their office prior to the service.** Visitors who have previously spoken with one of the Pastors, and who received permission to commune, do not need to seek permission for subsequent visits to the altar.

May 17, 2015-Kid's Crossing-Converting with Kindness. Pastor Pay tells how Paul and Silas witnessed to their jailer, forgave him for their mistreatment, and brought him to faith in Christ. Rev. Paul Winckler of Zion Lutheran Church in Rapid City delivers today's message "To Be Continued...". The scriptural base is Acts 1: 1-11. May 24, 2015-Kid's Crossing-Janitor Bob explains that when we "hope in the Lord" we can "trust" Him to see us through the storms that life brings us. Today's message, "God is on the move again" is presented by Rev Randy Sturzenbecher of Divine Shepherd Lutheran Church in Black Hawk, South Dakota.

Tornado Destruction-But not without God's protection.

Zion Lutheran Church (LCMS), Delmont, SD — There was no doubt where Zion Lutheran Church's Sunday school class turned when a tornado was headed for the town's historic church. The students and church leaders turned to God. And their prayers were answered. The church building caught the brunt of the storm, with its high steeple and pitched roof left as memories after a vicious tornado on Sunday tore through Delmont. The class of youth churchgoers was smaller than a normal Sunday, with only about seven students, said Barb Will, who teaches Sunday school. The class was already in the basement of the church, making Mother's Day cards, and moved to a small bathroom, where they huddled and prayed.

Mt. Calvary Council is announcing a special offering to be received to aid Zion Lutheran Church. Rev. Scott Spiehs the SD Disaster Relief Coordinator said, the only thing really needed right now are funds. Today we are going to make available special Delmont Relief Fund envelopes for you to take home. This special offering will be received next week or whenever you are able to give a gift for this purpose. If you use a check, please make the check out

to, "The South Dakota District of the LCMS", and ear mark the check with the phrase, "The Delmont Relief Fund". As this special relief offering comes in, we will forward them to the District Office. The ushers will be handing out the envelopes as you leave worship.

Another Matter: We rarely speak of money during the service at Mt. Calvary. However, the Church Council is concerned as the gap between budget goals and offerings has grown to the point that you needed to know. All the church bills are current as of May 12, 2015. The bills are being paid from the offerings of God's people and from the reserve funds. However, the checking account is in the red by 18k as of May 12, 2015. In mid April we had a positive balance of approximately \$5,000. Over the last several weeks, we have had high cash out flow. Please note, weekly needs for the General Fund is \$6,906.

So, let us have a <u>catch up goal</u> over the next month to eliminate the deficient. Remember what Scripture says, I Corinthians 16:1, "Now about the collection for God's people: Do what I told the Galatian churches to do. 2 On the first day of every week, each one of you should <u>set aside a sum of money</u> in keeping with his <u>income</u>, saving it up" - A sum means a portion or percentage of the income the Lord gives you. And again in another place the Holy Spirit wrote, "7 But just as you excel in everything—in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in complete earnestness and in your love for us—see that you also <u>excel in this grace of giving</u>.

As we approach summer vacations, outings, and travel, please remember your offerings to the Lord for the support of the work of "winning the lost and strengthening the faithful" here at Mt. Calvary. The offerings of God's people is also worship of Christ. If you have not been bringing a Christian tithe which is a portion of the income God provides, then please consider doing so. It is the Godly and Christian thing to do. Proverbs 3: ⁹Honor the LORD with your wealth and with the firstfruits of all your produce; ¹⁰then your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will be bursting with wine.
