SUNDAY SCHOOL NOTES Lesson 6 – Oct. 11 and Oct. 14

Today in Sunday School and on Wednesday at Kids 4 Christ, the lesson recalls the account of “Moses and the Burning Bush.” Just as God had Moses remove the sandals from his feet, God in Christ removes our sins from us, making us fit to approach God and stand in His presence. *Discuss, “Who makes us holy before God? What did Moses have to do, and why, in order to be in God’s presence?”*

Adult Bible Study - This Sunday the adult class will be hearing Rev. Dr. Robert Rahn. Rev. Rahn will also be speaking at each service about his travels to churches around the globe, where he has seen with his own eyes how God calls people to faith through the Lutheran literature available in their own language. To support this important mission effort, you may use the special offering envelope handed out this morning in the services. LHF was organized on Nov. 10, 1992 by Rev. Dr. Robert Rahn.

LHF is directed by a 15-member Board made up of pastors, teachers and lay people of the LCMS. LHF engages more than 300 individuals around the world who serve as translators, reviewers, editors, general linguists and theological specialists in order to provide the most accurate translations possible. LHF has published over 3 million Lutheran books, which are distributed freely to missionaries, churches and individuals.
