New Sound System

Mt. Calvary has a number of memorials to help meet future ministry goals, one of which is a new system to enhance sound quality for hearing and recording purposes. Last year sound engineers spent nearly a day measuring and examining our facility. The result was a plan to enhance sound quality to include no dead spots in the sanctuary at an estimated cost of \$54,000.00. We are closer to the goal as several gifts have come in over the last several months. If you worshipped in the activities center recently you heard the difference in quality of sound in the activities center verses the sanctuary. The first goal of a new sound system in the sanctuary is for even sound coverage ensuring an even sound intensity over the entire nave of the church. An effective way to ensure this is to provide even direct field sound coverage. The direct field is the sound that reaches the listener’s ears directly from the speaker or speakers.

Over the last several years Roger Kropuenske has kept the sound system going by replacing essential parts as well as by-passing some components to keep things working. Please thank him for that work. And please consider special gifts toward meeting this ministry goal.
