THE LOST SQUADRON



Deeply buried missing planes challenge 'slow and gradual' preconceptions.

FROM a secret US Army air base in Greenland, six P-38 Lightning fighter planes and two gigantic B-17 Flying Fortress bombers rose into the early dawn. The date was July 15, 1942, and they were headed for a British airfield to join the war against Hitler.

Heading east over the polar icecap, they ran into a massive blizzard. Flying blind, they heard that their first planned refueling stop, in Iceland, was "locked in", forcing them to return to their home base. As they approached this, however, critically low on fuel, they found that it, too, was closed. Realizing that their only hope was to crashland on the icy wastes


of Greenland's east coast, they desperately searched till they found a break in the cloud cover.

The nosewheel of the first plane to land hit a crevasse, which caused it to flip. Fortunately, the impact on the canopy of the 8-ton P-38 was cushioned by snow, and the pilot's injuries were minor. After they saw this, the rest of the squadron came in with their wheels up for belly landings. The planes were only lightly damaged.

All the crewmen were rescued unharmed by dogsled, about nine days later. However, the planes had to be abandoned where they had silted to a stop.

In the years to follow, a few people occasionally recalled the legendary Lost Squadron of 1942, but it was only in 1980 that anyone thought of a salvage mission. U.S. airplane dealer Patrick Epps told his








The P-38 Lightning was one of the deadliest planes to come out of WWII. Powered by twin 1200-hp Allison V-12 engines, it had one 20mm cannon and four .50 calibre machine guns in its nose. Operational from 1941–49, the nickname given to it by German pilots, on account of its double tail, was *Der Gabelschwanz Teufel* (the fork-tailed devil). They are a highly prized collector's item; only five were believed to still be flying at the time that the Lost Squadron P-38 was salvaged — under c. 75 metres (250 feet) of solid ice!



Cold Mining


Salvaging the P-38 from the glacier took hard work, all of which had to be performed in cramped surroundings in a rain of melting water and chunks of ice that periodically fell from the cavern roof. First, the cavern had to be made large enough to work in and all parts of the plane freed from the ice. Then (below right) experts had to disassemble the plane, an arduous process that frequently meant prying apart pieces frozen together for decades. Finally (below center) the plane's individual parts had to be hauled to the surface, a trip equal to hauling them up the side of a tall building.

GENETIC EVE GETS A GENETIC ADAM

Eight years ago, researchers "found" the mother of all humans, the proverbial Eve. By peeking into the cells of several ethnic groups, they traced the family tree of modern humans back 200,000 years to a single - albeit theoretical - woman. "Mitochondrial Eve,"



named for the part of the cell passed from the mother and examined in the study, was hardly the only female human who was bearing children at the time, but scientists said her genes were the ones that endured.



Now, Eve has an Adam. In two reports in last week's *Nature*, researchers suggest that virtually all modern men - 99.9 percent of them, says one scientist - are closely related genetically and share genes with one male ancestor dubbed "Y-chromosome Adam." Unlike other chromosomes, Y's are passed strictly from father to son, thus enabling scientists to follow the human race patrilineally.





Hyperbaric therapy helps young cerebral palsy patients

FORT WORTH, Texas — When he started hyperbaric oxygen therapy last February, Kenton Morgan's leg muscles had become so constricted, his knees clamped together and his lower legs scissored. He could no longer straddle a horse.

For the 13-year-old with cerebral palsy, that was tragic.

Kenton, who lives in the Fort Worth suburb of Burleson, loves therapeutic riding. It's his main social activity. His mother says he talks nonstop to the three helpers who lead and walk alongside the horse he's riding.

"I do love horses," Kenton says. "I got thrown off a horse once. It was scary — for Mom. ... My side walker caught me."

Kenton's orthopedic surgeon recommended muscle-release surgery to correct the problem but warned the procedure might have to be repeated as Kenton grows.

His father, Ken Morgan, got on the Internet and says he made "about a jillion phone calls," seeking alternatives. He found an experimental hyperbaric oxygen treatment program for cerebral palsy at the University of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston.

Breathing pure oxygen under increased pressure allows blood vessels to carry more oxygen deeper into tissue throughout the body, including the brain. The capillaries diffuse blood farther (into tissue) under pressure, so oxygen-rich blood is carried into areas it can't reach under normal pressure.

Hyperbaric oxygen is most often used to treat carbon monoxide poisoning and for hard-to-heal wounds such as crush in-

Oxygen halves infection

Higher dosage - 80 percent - makes difference

Researchers may have found a true ounce of prevention, reporting today that a few pennies' worth of oxygen can cut the risk of surgical infections in half — meaning thousands could be saved in medical bills.

Air is about 21 percent oxygen. But patients routinely get 30 percent oxygen during and after surgery, because lungs don't work well under anesthesia. The study tested whether a richer mixture would improve the outcome.

Boosting the oxygen level to 80 percent made a big difference. Twenty-eight of 250 patients on the standard mix developed infections, compared with only 13 out of 250 who got extra oxygen.

The study was published in today's

New England Journal of Medicine and was led by Dr. Daniel Sessler of the University of California at San Francisco.

The study is significant because it shows an easy, inexpensive way to make a big cut in medical bills, said Dr. Avery Tung, an assistant professor of anesthesia at the University of Chicago's medical school.

According to another study, post-operative infections add an average of \$12,500 to the cost of cancer surgery. The only cost to the richer-oxygen treatment is about three cents' worth of oxygen.

"It's just a matter of setting two knobs in different positions. Both knobs need to be set anyway, and you just turn them a little more to get more oxygen," Sessler said.

Doctors have worried that extra oxygen might make the lungs more likely to collapse. However, he said, a study of his last year in the journal Anesthesiology found no difference in the percentage of such collapses on high and normal doses of oxygen.

There was also an unexpected benefit — patients who got extra oxygen were half as likely to be nauseated after surgery.

Donauspital in Vienna, Vienna General Hospital and University Hospital Eppendorf in Hamburg, Germany.

Scientists already knew that the white blood cells known as neutrophils use oxygen to kill germs. And they knew that high levels of oxygen in body tissues help prevent infection and that breathing higher levels of oxygen put more oxygen into the tissues. What they did not know was whether it made a difference in patients' healing.

"This shows it's not just a theoretical benefit but a real benefit, and that it's much greater than you might have expected," Sessler said. "It's an enormous benefit for no cost and effort and risk."

The study looked at bowel surgery patients because they have the highest risk of infection. The findings might have even greater implications for burn units, since infections cause most deaths there, said Tung, head of his hospital's burn unit.

"If I had a wish list of another study I'd like to see, I'd like to see the effect of this on preventing infections other than wound infections," he said. "Or whether oxygen therapy might be used to speed healing" of other infections.

Hyperbaric device aids children



In 1996, Dr. Josephine Feingold's daughter, Elisa, was diagnosed with cerebral palsy. After a series of treatments in a hyperbaric oxygen chamber, the 5-year-old showed better concentration and began to talk.

To continue Elisa's therapy, Feingold mortgaged her home and started her practice, Hudson Valley Hyperbarics, 13 months ago in Southeast, N.Y.

Treating those afflicted by autism or cerebral palsy is a non-traditional use of HBOT, a medical treatment that increases the body's healing process by increasing oxygen levels. The non-traditional applications are not government approved and insurance companies won't cover the cost. Hospitals with chambers — about 400 in the United States — treat only approved afflictions, most dealing with traumatic flesh injuries, sending those seeking alternative therapies to practices like Feingold's.

Questions about its effectiveness and the expense — \$200 for each 90-minute stay in the machine — haven't deterred Feingold's patients or dampened the relief of their caregivers. Most come for 40


Ancient Increase in Oxygen Tied to Surge of Giant Insects

NEW YORK—A sharp increase in oxygen in the ancient atmosphere may have led to giant insects and helped animals with backbones make the evolutionary switch from water to land, researchers say.


The changes in the ancient animals support the hypothesis that oxygen concentration started rising about 400 million years ago and peaked 290 million years ago before declining, said biology professor Carl Gans of the University of Michigan.

The hypothesis says the oxygen reached an estimated 35% of the atmosphere, compared with the present level of 21%. Gans and co-authors noted in the journal *Nature*.

Insects get oxygen by diffusion through tiny tubes in their bodies, and the increase in atmospheric oxygen would have let ancient insects take in more.




