The Dot Arnold Scholarship

The Dot Arnold Scholarship (DAS) Fund at Nolensville First United Methodist Church was set up to honor Dot Arnold. For many years, Granny Dot, as she is called, served as a member of the choir, as organist, pianist, and choir director at our church. Granny Dot has been involved in the music ministry for more than fifty years. The DAS was originally established more than ten years ago. Since that time, the music ministry at Nolensville First UMC has been greatly expanded, and much of that expansion is based on the solid foundation of music ministry generated by Granny Dot. Therefore, the purpose of this document is to reestablish and reaffirm the Dot Arnold Scholarship for today's Nolensville First UMC.

The DAS is funded through direct donations and through the fundraising efforts of the music ministry program of Nolensville First UMC. We anticipate the ability to fund one or more initial scholarships, and several renewal scholarships, each year in the amount of \$500 each.

Selection of the recipient(s) of the DAS will be made by a committee of at least five active adult participants in the Nolensville First UMC music ministry as appointed by the Director of Music. Any parent of an applicant may not serve on the committee.

Students eligible for consideration for the DAS (initial):

High school seniors who will be attending an accredited college or university and have been active in the music program at Nolensville First UMC during their high school years. While active participation as a singer and/or instrumentalist is preferred, a student who has actively and continuously served in a support role within the music ministry program may also be considered eligible. Those eligible students must complete all portions of the application process and meet the application deadline to be considered by the DAS committee.

Students eligible for consideration for the DAS (renewal):

Renewal scholarships are available to previous recipients of the DAS who remain current students at an accredited college or university. Continued active participation in the music ministry of Nolensville First UMC at appropriate times during the school year and between school sessions is considered a requirement for renewal. Those eligible students must complete all portions of the application process and meet the application deadline to be considered by the DAS committee.

Application Checklist Initial Scholarship for High School Seniors

- 1. Answer all questions on the initial application succinctly. Use front side only for pages submitted.
- 2. Secure a letter of recommendation from one of your high school teachers using the form provided. The letter should be sealed in an envelope with the teacher's signature across the flap when it is submitted.
- 3. Request a member of Nolensville First UMC complete the required music ministry recommendation form. This form could be completed by someone who has worked with you in a music ministry activity or someone who wishes to comment on how your involvement in music ministry has been meaningful to him/her. (May not be your parent or grandparent.) The form should be sealed in an envelope with the signature of the person who completed the form across the flap when submitted.
- 4. Return the three items listed above in ONE envelope BY MAY 15 to:
