Symptoms of Covid-19		

- Everyone with a positive COVID-19 result, regardless of vaccination status should stay home and isolate from others for a minimum of 5 days from symptom onset (Day 0).
- Symptoms can be one or more of the following: cough, loss of taste and/or smell, fever, chills, congestion, sore throat, headache,
- After 5 days from symptom onset (Day0) and improving symptoms or health provider note indicating a date for return to school, including fever-free for 24 hours.
