To reserve a room call the hotel directly at: (580) 540-4351 and ask for the **LCMS Conference block rate**. The cost is \$80, not including tax, and includes a hot breakfast on Tuesday.

<u>The deadline</u> to guarantee the conference rate was <u>Monday, September 24 as previously</u> <u>announced.</u> Even though the block of rooms is to be made available to the public on September 25, the special block price remains in effect for the Conference as long as they have rooms available. Therefore it is advantageous to make reservations as soon as possible.

To be tax exempt, book your room and then email a copy of the tax exempt certificate for your congregation or school, if applicable, to the hotel manager: ronaldroberson@hotmail.com The Hotel staff will appreciate this greatly, as it will expedite checking in and out.

<u>Emeritus Workers</u> - You are responsible to reserve and provide payment for your hotel room. Recreation: In addition to Golf, we have several options to share fellowship and relieve stress.

Sporting Clays: You may provide your own shotgun, ammunition, and clay targets (at no charge). Shotguns are available to borrow on site. Shells and clays are available for purchase at a total cost of \$15 for a round of 25. Order below and specify either 12 gauge or 20 gauge shells. Shells and clays may also be ordered in advance if you bring a shotgun to use. Everyone is asked to bring eye and ear protection for themselves and to share with others.

Target shooting: You are invited to bring guns, ammo, & targets and show-off or practice your skills.

Fishing: Bring fishing equipment for relaxation and to brag about your catch. There will also be equipment to borrow.

Horseshoes: You can play horseshoes at the recreation site or at Redeemer.

Basketball: Shoot some hoops at Redeemer, if we have the space in the Family Life Center Gym.

The only cost is the purchase of shells and clays. The recreation site is about 19 miles east of the Highway 412 and US. 81 intersection, 25-30 minutes east of Redeemer. It is at the NW corner of the intersection of Highway 412 and Knox Rd (3 miles east of Highway 74).
