December 6 – The Stockings Ephesians 2

⁴ But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, ⁵ even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ... (Ephesians 2:4-5)

The picture of Santa today has changed a lot from who St. Nicholas really was. Today, Santa delivers gifts made by others to those who've been "nice." The real St. Nick gave away his own wealth to those who were in great need, because he wanted to reflect God's love.

For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor, so that you by his poverty might become rich. (2 Corinthians 8:9)

When has someone shared their riches with you? ~ Did you deserve it? ~ How did you feel when you received it? ~ When have you shared your riches with someone in need? ~ How did you feel when you gave it?


