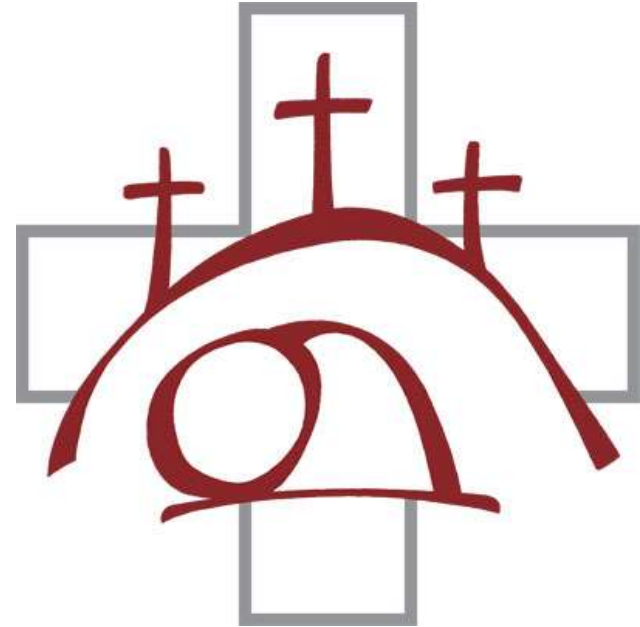

**Good morning** everyone, and welcome to worship at New Hope Lutheran Church today! A special welcome to our visitors!
