Grace and peace to all the Saints at New Hope Lutheran Church,

Among the blessings the Lord has given us is His Word. In His word is contained what He wants us to know about Him. MINISTRY CLARITY TEAM INTRODUCTION LETTER

Dear Saints of New Hope Lutheran Church,

In March of 2015, a new church was formed, New Hope Lutheran Church of Licking County, Ohio. The church, in coordination with the Ohio District - Lutheran Church Missouri Synod (LCMS), was created through the merger of Our Savior Lutheran Church - Newark and Pilgrim Lutheran Church - Granville. Both churches came with over a fifty-year history and traditions. In the last seven years, there have been numerous changes. We have added two new pastors, Pastor Mark (2016) and Pastor Terry (2019). We have also taken a bold step to reach out to our community with the addition of Hope's Door.

Over the years, the composition of our congregation has changed. Naturally, we have members that have gone to be with the Lord, we have had members move away, we have had members move in, we have people from the community take the step to come and join us. These are good and natural events in the lifecycle of a church. But we as the executive board feel now after these seven plus years it is time to take a renewed look at our ministry.

Recorded in Matthew 28, just prior to His ascension, Jesus instructed His Church, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age." This is often referred to as the "Great Commission". It is our desire to follow the model our Lord and Savior set out for us. It is our desire to get the lifesaving message of Christ, crucified, risen and returning to the members of our church and the members of our community.

After prayer and discussion, the board has contracted with Lutheran Church Ministry Clarity Team. This process is based on you, the members of New Hope Lutheran Church. This program will start with this survey, we are also constructing a visioning team that will interpret the results. We will have a visioning event to present the results. We will also have visits from the program pastor and a series of meetings to develop a plan.

In the meantime, if Pastor Mark ask you to join the Visioning Team, please prayerfully consider joining the team. Please make an effort to attend the visioning meeting so your voice can be heard. Please take the time to fill out the questionnaire found below; please answer the questions as completely as you can. Please note, the Visioning team and the executive board will not have direct access to the results. The teams will only receive filtered non-specific results. 




