

Using the State of Illinois guidelines, the Church Council President, Board of Elders, Board of Trustees, and staff have set the following plans for onsite worship which will begin on June 28th:

- Services will be held at 8:00 am and 10:30 am.
- Services will have limited singing, limited group recitation, and will be 20-30 minutes in length as we ease into this schedule.
- No Education Hour will be held between services.
- To maintain social distancing, only designated pews will be open with a limited number allowed per pew (households may sit together). Ushers will direct you where to sit.
- Face masks are required and will be provided if you do not have one.
- Contact with common items will be limited (verbal-only greeting, offering box located in narthex, and removal of hymnals, pew Bibles, and attendance pads).
- Communion (held at both services on the first, third, and fifth Sundays) will be distributed in a different format rather than kneeling at the altar.
- Following services, congregants will be dismissed by ushers and expected to leave the building immediately after worship. Fellowship time with refreshments will NOT be held.
- Touched surfaces will be sanitized before and after services.

Although many are very much looking forward to onsite worship, this may not fit everyone's situation. Please...

- Attend onsite worship only if you feel comfortable. Online worship resources will still be available, or a recording can be delivered to your home.
- Do not attend worship if you are feeling ill, have respiratory symptoms, or have a fever.
