

Using the current State of Illinois guidelines, the Church Council President, Board of Elders, and Board of Trustees have set the following plans for onsite worship:

- Services will be held at 8:00 am and 10:30 am.
- Face masks are required regardless of vaccination status and will be provided if you do not have one.
- To encourage social distancing, every other pew will be open with social distancing recommended within the pew.
- Communion (held at both services on the first, third, and fifth Sundays) will be distributed in the pews rather than kneeling at the altar. All servers will be masked.
- All areas of the building are fully open, allowing access to church mailboxes and all restrooms.

Please remember the following:

- Attend onsite worship only if you feel comfortable. Online worship resources will still be available, or a recording can be delivered to your home.
- Do not attend worship if you are feeling ill, have respiratory symptoms, or have a fever.
