- ★ Pastor reported that video worship segments will continue for the foreseeable future.
- ★ Our staff members, Gina, Bess, Rhonda and Sharda, continue to provide excellent service to OSL and keep things moving forward at this time. Josh Weesner and volunteers are keeping the Food Pantry running and continue to provide this valuable service to the community.

- ★ Pastor will be working with the Bethany Home Spiritual leader on a taped bible study to be made available to Bethany residents.

- ★ JoAnn gave the treasurer's report. We ended in the black for the month of March. JoAnn recommended delaying a professional audit until 2021. The in-house audit has not been done to date. Automatic pledges from Vanco Payment Service were brought up to date.
