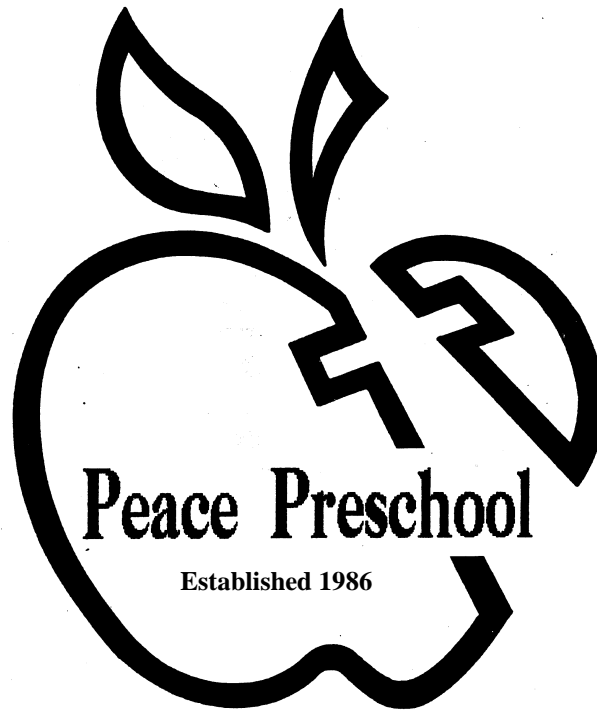


Peace Lutheran Church Preschool Enrollment Packet 2019-2020
