 - b. With pandemic in mind, possibly make appointments for picture time
 - c. Have pastor come to chapel and welcome children to church & preschool and invite them to Sunday School
 - d. Fall Festival-use last year's preschool info to invite families back this year through a personal call
 - e. Personal calls could be used at Christmas, Easter, etc.
 - f. Preschool scholarships can be extended to families in extenuating situations
 - g. Welcome letter/email to the preschool families from the church
