Green- Green is the appointed color for all but a few of the Sundays during the Epiphany and Pentecost seasons. Consequently, green may be used an average of six to eight months of any given liturgical year! Epiphany's message of Christ's revelation to the Gentiles along with the season's traditional emphasis on extending Christ's kingdom through missions, calls for the use of green-the color symbolic of growth. The Sundays following Pentecost, observed as "the time of the church," share a somewhat similar theme as that of Epiphany. Affectionately called the season of the "green meadow," no doubt due to the fact of green being the established color, these Sundays also emphasize the subject of growth. Green is a neutral color, but there is nothing colorless about our need to grow and mature as disciples of Jesus Christ. That's why the "green meadow" time of the church year is so lengthy. At present I am only aware of 2 ringers wanting to play. We would need 7 or 8 ringers to cover 2 octaves and 10 or 11 to cover the 3 octaves of bells that we have. In the past we have gotten by with fewer ringers but there have been experienced ringers able to cover more than one part. It is not necessary to be able to read notes to ring with us, as we color code the music for the bells a ringer is responsible for. Counting is an important skill.
