Dear Members and Friends,

As I write this Transfiguration Sunday has just passed. It is the Sunday when we focus on when Jesus' appearance was changed in front of Peter, James and John. After witnessing such a fantastic event the disciples wanted to stay and bask in the glory of the presence of God, but Jesus bids them return down the mountain and back into mix of events that would put him on the cross.

I am not sure that there is a better metaphor for life than this. If we had our way we would bounce through life across the mountaintop experiences without ever having to face the valley, the depths, the cross. Yet as we all know, life is full of events that are less than the stellar, exciting, mountaintop experiences we crave.

Perhaps we need an adjustment to our vision. God in his grace and mercy gives us mountaintop experiences. Those wonderful times we have with family when we feel loved, cared for and important in their eyes; the feeling of God's presence wrapped around us. Yet these times are given, so that we might be prepared and ready to face the times of grief, loneliness, separation, and suffering. God is with us in those times as well. Note that Jesus led the disciples back down the mountain. He didn't stay up there and tell the others to go by themselves. And so he leads us back into the world, back into the conflict that is caused because we are Christians and refuse to follow the ways of the world.

We pray that God would strengthen us so that we might be faithful disciples, following Jesus wherever he leads, proclaiming him to be Lord and King. I close with the words of Henry Lyte in that great hymn of the church "Abide with Me."

I need thy presence ev'ry passing hour, what but thy grace can foil the tempters pow'r

Who like thyself my guide and stay can be, through cloud and sunshine oh abide with me

Hold thou thy cross before my closing eyes shine through the gloom, and point me to the skies;

Heav'n's mourning breaks and earth's vain shadows flee In life, in death, O Lord, abide with me.


