It has been a long 5 months since we were quarantined and, for the most part, forced to stay inside. I am hoping as I am sure you are as well that this comes to an end very soon. Although it has been a while since we were able to talk in person, I have enjoyed the phone conversations we have been able to have over this time period. Those conversations have allowed me to get to know you a little better. We are able to carry on more of a conversation perhaps than just briefly greeting each other at church.

You will click on the link to join the bible class. You might want to download zoom on your computer and play around with it a little bit so you are familiar with it when we begin. This class will be conducted at <u>11 am on Wednesdays beginning on September 9</u>. When the quarantine began we were studying Matthew and had to quit. Pastor will pick up that study with Lesson 8 (Matthew 19:16 – 23:39). If you are new to the class or misplace your study guide you can pick up a copy of the complete study in the church office. 
