Jesus Never Fails

Read Mark 4:35-41 and Psalm 121

**And [Jesus] awoke and rebuked the wind and said to the sea,
"Peace! Be still!" And the wind ceased, and there was a great
calm. Mark 4:39**

Where is Jesus in our suffering? The disciples were at their wits end. They were battling the storm — but where was Jesus? Sound asleep.

"Lord, don't You care?"

How often are we like the disciples! We aren't buffeted by wind and sea, but by troubled marriages, wayward kids, stressful jobs, limited finances, failing health, gnawing loneliness, or approaching death.

"Lord, don't You care?"

Indeed, the Lord does care. He cared for the disciples enough to silence the howling wind and calm the raging sea. He cares for us all enough to come into our flesh, to take on our grief and sorrows, to bear our burdens and cares, to endure our suffering and our death. 

... you have made it possible to reach children through Gospel Adventures, easily accessible by families, schools, and churches



Membership Covenant

In order for the congregation and the Leadership to deal effectively with issues in the congregation, the following guidelines are to be followed:

- 1. All members affirm their right to express their opinions about the life and ministry of the congregation.**
- 2. The congregation operates with a direct democracy form of government that allows members to share their opinions directly with the pastor, leadership, committees, and congregational meetings.**
- 3. When members of the congregation express an opinion to leadership, the leadership person shall ask, 'What would you like me to do with this information?'**
- 4. When members of the congregation express an opinion to a leadership team member, the member shall be invited to bring the information/opinion to the next council/leadership meeting. The time and date shall be given.**
- 5. If the member does not wish to appear in person, the leadership member shall ask the member for permission to use their name in reporting. If permission is not given, the leadership member shall say, 'I'm sorry, but I will not be able to report this to the council since we do not deal with anonymous letters or comments.'**
- 6. If permission is given, the leadership member shall report the information / opinion to the leadership team and use the member's name.**
- 7. At his/her discretion, a leadership member may ask that the member refer this issue to another member for presentation.**
- 8. Each issue shall be placed on the agenda and written in the minutes along with the action taken by the leadership. Action may include: "Received as information," "Pastor and/or President to visit member and report at next meeting," etc.**
- 9. Opinions may be shared in writing with the council and shall be handled in the above-mentioned manner if the letter or statement is signed. While the covenant uses language regarding the leadership team, the same procedures apply to all boards and committees. May the Spirit give us grace to grow as a healthy congregation.**
