Time, Talent, Treasure

The Time, Talent, and Treasure Committee engages church members to serve God with their Time, Talent, and Treasure.

- Time and Talent Team Volunteers are needed who know their way around a computer and can collect and organize time and talent information. We need to identify Godgiven skills and talents so we can plug folks into a ministry at PIC.
- Treasure Team God gives us so much and it is our privilege to joyfully return to Him a portion of our time, talents, and treasures. Last year's stewardship campaign was a very valuable educational experience. Help is needed in encouraging the congregation each year to be faithful in this part of their daily walk with the Lord.
- Recruitment Team Are you blessed with people skills and have the knack of matching the right person up with the right job? The Recruitment and Placement Team helps to fill open spots on all church teams and committees with just the right member at PIC, and involves working with time and talent info and making phone calls or e-mails.

Community Committee

The Community Committee is responsible for bringing together church members to help the community within and outside the church.

- Compassion Team There are so many needy families in our own church, in Hermantown, and in the Duluth area. Help our congregation share some of God's blessings with those who are hurting and struggling and, in this way, also share with them the love of Christ.
- <u>Ruby's Pantry Team</u> There are hungry people in our own neighborhoods as well in the Duluth area. Help our congregation share God's goodness with those who don't know where to find their next meal.
- Member Merge Team Help make the transition of new members into the life of our congregation an easy one. Help match "shepherd families" to new member families for a brief time after they join PIC.
- □ <u>Rally Sunday Team</u> Everyone loves Rally Sunday. Help is needed to organize the annual outdoor service and family picnic each September.
- Bell Ringing Team Volunteer in November and December to ring bells for the Salvation Army at a local retail outlet. Ideal for families to take a two-hour shift and ring bells together for the needy.
- Marketing Team Creative people are needed to advertise the great things God does at Peace In Christ through a variety of marketing strategies. Help is needed to market small projects and big events alike.
- <u>Christian Learning Team</u> Wouldn't it be nice to have one or two special educational events at PIC each year? Ideas might include marriage enrichment, how to raise Christian kids, estate planning, stress management, field dressing white tail deer, etc. Sign up if you would like to help make such events happen.
- Welcome Center Team Making positive contact with Sunday morning visitors is the first step in turning visitors into members. Help is needed to coordinate how we minister to these new potential PIC family members.
- <u>PIC History Team</u> God has blessed our church greatly over the years. The church history team records these blessings and passes the history of our congregation on to future generations. Get involved in you are a history buff and would like to organize memories for the enjoyment of all our church members.
- PIC Website Team People go online to fine a church home these days. We have a great church website and need a computer savvy volunteer or two to help keep help navigate within the website and keep it up to date.

Discipleship

The Discipleship Committee is responsible for the spiritual and educational enrichment of our church members.

- Prayer Groups Team Prayer changes hearts and moves mountains. Encourage and support prayer groups at Peace In Christ. Wouldn't an online prayer group be great?
- Youth Support Team Enjoy working with kids? Assist Ruth as an adult mentor for youth. Serve as a driver, listening ear, friend, and maybe even teach. Play games with them, laugh at their jokes, hold them responsible, pray for them, and be a Godly example!
- <u>Confirmation Support Team</u> Give pastor some help with the confirmation classes.
 Organize weekly treats, ride sharing, and help with community service projects.
- Pre-School Support Team The pre-school team is a work in progress designed to uplift our new preschool ministry. Sign up if you are interested in supporting the ongoing Christian education of our littlest members.
- <u>Missions Team</u> Help our church reach out with the love of Christ beyond northern Minnesota. This includes the mission field in our own nation as well as overseas.
- Sunday School Team There is no greater privilege or responsibility than sharing Jesus Christ with our children. Get involved with teaching, supporting, helping and managing the Sunday morning education of all PIC kids. Help is needed with the annual Christmas program too!
- Vacation Bible School Team Kids love VBS and Peace In Christ has always had a great program. Plug into providing a great week of proclaiming and sharing Christ's love during the summer. Coordinators, teachers, helpers, snacks, crafts, recreation, and music are all part of this ministry.
- College Ministry Team Wouldn't it be great to invite college students in the Duluth area to get involved at PIC during their college years? Also, what about students from our own church who have gone off to college? Shouldn't we keep in contact with them? Help is needed to support this ministry!

PIC Life

The PIC Life Committee is responsible for church events, special meals, and encouraging church member fellowship.

- Cookie Walk Team Help bake, set up, serve breakfast and clean up to pull off the oldest and most successful PIC fundraiser of them all. Usually held the first Saturday in December each year.
- Fellowship Events Team Help plan fun events for members to laugh and get to know one another. Ideas might include a bonfire, talent show, valentine dinner, sleigh ride, sledding, camping trip, road kill buffet, etc. Use your imagination.
- <u>"We Care" Meals Team</u> Help serve the catered meals that often take place at church following a funeral. Also organize "show we care" meals donated by members to help at special times such as a death in the family, new baby, surgery, just moved to town, etc.
- Special Dinners Team The Spring Dinner and the Fall Dinner are two examples of special dinners that take place at PIC. Volunteers are needed to help plan our special dinners so they run smoothly, get lots of folks involved, and are successful events.
- Memorials Team Volunteers are needed to organize and manage memorials and endowments at Peace In Christ. This ministry could really become a wonderful longlasting financial blessing for our congregation.
- Senior Fellowship Team Retired volunteers are needed to get this group officially on the church map and coordinate efforts to build strong relationships, provide support and have fun within this population.
- Sunday Fellowship Team "Give me after worship treats or give me death." No one has ever said this but Lutherans do love their Sunday morning coffee and treats. Help keep this tradition strong as Sunday morning snacks keep lots of folks smiling each week.
- <u>Funerals Meals Team</u> This team helps with the set-up, serving, and clean-up of funeral meals. These meals take place at Peace in Christ following the funeral. This is a wonderful way to help the family of the deceased. By taking care of the meals, the family can be together without the worry and added stress of meal details.

Worship

The Worship Committee teams help coordinate all activities related to worship services.

- Acolytes Team How would you like to work with the brave teens who attempt to light the candles each Sunday? Help is needed to train the acolytes, create an acolyte schedule, and manage participation throughout the year.
- Altar Guild Team Taking care of the holy of holies in God's church goes way back to those who cared for the "tent church" of the Israelites. Volunteers are needed to care for the altar and chancel areas in God's house, set up for communion services, take care of altar flowers, and care for altar cloths, etc.
- Audio/Visual Team Those who run the big screen on Sunday mornings are as vital as the pastor or the organist – worship can't take place without them. Anyone who can turn on a computer and run a power point program can handle this much needed and techno way of serving the Lord.
- Choir Team If you love to sing God's praises, volunteer to be part of the church choir. Weekly practices are a spiritual oasis and stress reliever. We are blessed with a wonderful conductor, pianist, and singers. There are lots of fun and laughter amid the musical notes.
- Praise Band Team There are many ways to worship the Lord and music variety is the spice of worship! If you love to sing or play Christian praise music, sign up for the Praise Band Team. This group energizes worship with their music on a regular basis during the year.
- □ <u>Organists Team</u> If you are blessed with piano and/or organ playing skills, please let our worship team in on your secret! Back-up coverage may be needed at times.
- Worship Greeters Team A smiling face is a great way to welcome visitors who make their way to PIC on Sunday mornings. Volunteers are needed to say hello to visitors, encourage them to sign the guest book, and answer basic questions they might have.
- <u>Ushers Team</u> Men, women, and teens can easily help with ushering duties on Sunday mornings. A simple but much needed way of serving the Lord and ensuring that worship services go smoothly during the year.
- Scripture Readers Team If you enjoy reading God's Word and have no qualms about reading from the lectern on Sunday mornings, sign up for this unique way of serving the Lord. Readers take care of the Old Testament and Epistle readings.
- Worship Chimes Team Sign up if you enjoy making beautiful music for the Lord. Very little musical experience is required. Leaders will teach you how to play these simple instruments. This team will play from time to time on Sunday mornings and for special services.

Operations

The Operations Committee is responsible for the church's security, technology, custodial care and overall operations.

- Security Team This would involve one or two individuals who would be in charge of the overall security at Peace in Christ. Both members and non-members make requests to use our church facility and volunteers are needed to coordinate these requests.
- <u>Technology Team</u> Volunteers are needed whom God has blessed with computer and technology skills. Help keep the church computers running smoothly and be available to troubleshoot when needed.
- □ <u>Insurance Team</u> Help keep a handle on church insurance to make sure that God's family and property is properly covered. Lend a hand if insurance is your thing!
- Property Maintenance Team God has blessed us with a beautiful church facility that needs to be kept up on a regular basis. Lend a helping hand if your hand is good at holding a rake, paint brush, lawnmower, etc.
- Lawn/Landscaping Team If you love attacking grass and weeds or are a landscaping guru, please consider helping keep the church grounds looking great. Check this team if you don't mind getting your hands dirty.
- <u>Purchase Supply Team</u> If you like to shop this might just be the spot for you.
 Volunteers are needed to keep certain cleaning, kitchen, and office items in stock.
 Usually involves a trip or two to Sam's Club on a regular basis.
- Custodial Care Team Volunteers would provide occasional extra elbow grease on an as needed basis to keep our church facility spic and span. Help might include cleanup prior to or following a wedding, funeral, special service or major church event.
- Kitchen Team The church kitchen gets used quite a bit by lots of different people and groups. Help maintain and manage the kitchen as well as help develop a kitchen use policy.
- Worship Decorating Team Christmas and Easter are two times during the year that God's house is specially decorated to add to our worship services. Volunteers are needed to put up and take down decorations each year.
- LCEF Team The Lutheran Church Extension Fund is like a credit union for Missouri Synod Lutherans. They provide low interest construction loans for churches as well as a ton of different savings accounts for adults and kids. Sign up if you would like to represent the LCEF and pass needed information to members of our congregation.
- Subcontracts Team There are certain services that the congregation contracts out such as Farmers Brothers Coffee, copier maintenance, paper supplies etc. A volunteer or two would keep an eye on and manage all subcontract.
