

At school we'll be learning...

God Has a Season for Everything**

This week's theme is about the new year! The preschoolers will learn about telling time, using a calendar, and understanding the different seasons of the year. Time can be measured on a clock, by watching the sun, or experiencing the seasons. We'll learn that there is a time for everything - a time to be quiet, noisy, joyful, sad, tired, and excited. There is a time for eating, sleeping, cleaning up, celebrating birthdays, and enjoying holidays.
