Read Proverbs 7

Notes from podcast:

What new ways does Solomon encourage his son to pay attention to his warnings and words of wisdom?

What is the main focus of this chapter that Solomon is once again warning his son about?

Again, why does Solomon think this one topic is worthy of three chapters worth of warnings?

What has Solomon seen through the window?

Do you think this is a father confessing his own sin or literally about him observing others do this?

Reflect on how and when you can appropriately confess some of your sins to your children in order to help them learn from your mistakes.

So, what is the scene Solomon is witnessing here?

Is this woman a prostitute?

What is her struggle?

How does verse 12 connect to 1 Peter 5:8?

Who makes the first move?

What do we learn about this woman in verse 14?

What is her offer to this young man?

How does this accurately reflect all temptation?

Can you empathize with what this young man is feeling as she seduces him?

When she wins and gets what she wants, what happens to the young man?

Do you think this is an illustration that would impact your son or children? If not, what illustration would they better understand?

What is always the result of sexual sins?

How does Solomon conclude this whole chapter?

This is good for us as Christian men to hear, but also important for us to teach to the next generation!
