Pam Lammi

- A. July net income was \$9662. Year to date net income is \$101,336. The PIC mortgage balance is \$457,895.
- B. Pam is working on setting up Taylor Wheeler's payroll.
- C. Julie Hendricks moved to start a Financial Review in January 2022 using the Synod guidelines with two volunteers from the congregation. Grant Forsyth seconded and the motion carried. Eric Hill will contact the people that performed the last review time to see if they would be willing to do it again.

- A. We are patiently awaiting the arrival of our new DCE, Taylor Wheeler.
- B. Pre-School:
 - 1. The preschool is currently interviewing teacher candidates. If successful, this would allow them to have two teachers on staff, which is consistent with past staffing structure. If they are unsuccessful, they will look for an aid
 - 2. Enrollment numbers are up over 2020-2021 but still lower than prepandemic. It is known that some families are continuing to home school.
- B. Youth:
 - 1. NYG has been a key focus. There are 15 youth currently signed up and recruiting continues. Paula is organizing a personal reach out email to all eligible youth. She is also planning for an Adult Leader meeting in early to mid-September to present the Houston info she learned at the leader convention. Early registration and commitment is very important and will be stressed. The Kwik Trip fundraiser continues and a gift card fundraiser is being organized by Barb Harris and Brenda Hill. Other fundraisers being discussed include the envelope fundraiser and drive-in eats.
 - 2. A Youth Event was held at the HIIIs on 8/17.
- c. VBS:
 - 1. VBS week went very smoothly! There were lots of new volunteers compared to the past and it was especially exciting to see more male station leaders! A volunteer appreciation night was held at

Bridgeman's. Katie and Kari will debrief and document for next year's planning.

- D. Missions:
 - 1. The new dates for the mission trip to Puerto Rico are February 18-26, 2023.
 - 2. There are currently 10 individuals committed to the trip, leaving 6 openings.
- E. Sunday School:
 - 1. Melissa Hedegaard has volunteered to be the Sunday School Team Leader.
 - Six individuals have volunteered to be Sunday School teachers and we
 continue to target individuals that may be interested. We are working to
 determine which classes we should consider blending as well as
 assembling a substitute list.
 - 3. We are working to organize the new curriculum so we are ready to start Sunday School on 9/19. We are also looking to establish a training session for teachers so they are able to access the materials and lesson which will include a plan to access digital resources.
