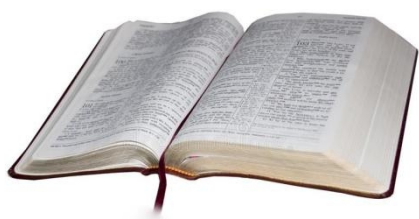


Pastor Ron will be away on February 14<sup>th</sup> and we are blessed to have Pastor John Stieve take his place for morning Worship and Bible Study.

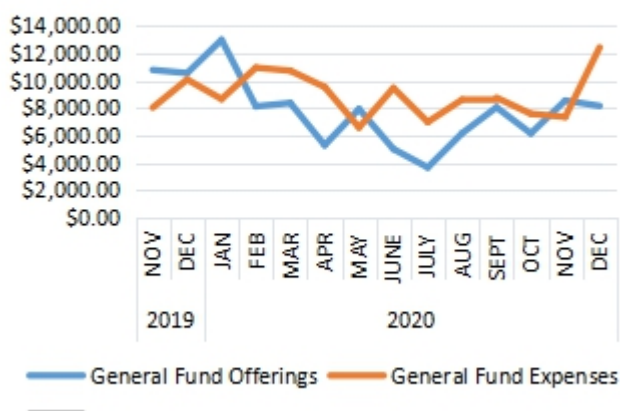


We ended 2020 with 1,426 fewer in attendance than in 2019.

We had a little over \$20,000 left in our expense budget.

We ended the year in the black by a little over \$30,000 with a total income of \$137,492 and expenses of \$107,398. (This included the Covid-19 CARES Act PPP Loan of \$22,078.96 which we did not have to pay back).
