


PITV HAPPENINGS NEWSLETTER March 2021

Our Covid-19 Safety Protocols

We practice social distancing and sanitizing. We have blocked off every other row. We do not mandate mask wearing, but encourage it. We also encourage those not wearing masks to sit in the front 3 rows. The Pastor and Elders wear masks and gloves for Holy Communion, which is also now done with social distancing. All Hymns are printed in the Bulletin. We have a TV for live-streaming in the Narthex in case we have overflow. After Worship Service we exit from the back rows first working our way to the front rows.

Our cleaning service sanitizes each week and hand sanitizers are readily available in the Narthex and restrooms.

From Pastor Ron

I had a wonderful experience preaching at San Pablo Lutheran Church, El Paso, TX, for Pastor Heimer. It was a bi lingual worship service and Pastor John Benito translated my sermon in Spanish as I preached. The people were very much and effectively fed with the Gospel Message along with the body and blood of our Lord.

I. MINISTRY:

Ysleta Lutheran Mission and Human Care Ministries is on 4.2 acres and San Pablo Lutheran Church which is on this property is at least 150 years old and was active during the times of General Pershing in the early times of Western United States History. The ministry has the following ministerial arteries,

- A. Radio and TV Ministry: A radio program is aired through the Christian Radio Station in El Paso once a week on Saturdays. The program is recorded in the studios on-site at Ysleta Lutheran Mission and Human Care. The TV Ministry is a Christian talk production.
- B. Food Distribution Ministry: Every Saturday the Mission serves an average of 150 families after Covid.
- C. Clothing and Toys Distribution Ministry: they give out clothing, toys and blankets

monthly.

- D. Divine Worship Service: is broadcast on line on Sunday Mornings.
- E. Cuban Ministry: Ysleta Lutheran Mission works with a church in Cuba in a congruent ministry.
- F. Prison and Detention Ministry: Pastor Carl Hiemer conducts a prison and detention ministry outreach every Saturday.
- G. Thrift Shop: Clothing and home goods are provided for purchase by the El Paso community.
- H. San Pablo Marachi: This is Marachi Music Ministry that provides its ministry nationwide.
- I. Rota Care Clinic: A free clinic to the El Paso Community that is conducted every Saturday from 9AM to 12 Noon that is coordinated with the Rotary Club of El Paso. They provide various medical services to the community free of charge.
- J. Servant Group Ministry: Mission Teams are able to come to El Paso for various projects to include building homes, doing VBS, Medical Clinics and sharing the Gospel, dental clinics and vision clinics on both sides of the border.

II. Outreach:

This Mission reaches out to El Paso Texas, Juarez Mexico, Cub a, Chihuahua Mexico with Pastor Tabar and even in San Lorenzo Mexico. Their ministry spreads over the United States through San Pablo Marachi.

III. Needs:

Ysleta Mission and Home Care has immediate and long term needs. They need ground paving done, as well as infra structure work to be completed. The San Pablo Lutheran Church is at least 150 years old and needs some repairs and property enhancements.

The immediate and pressing need is to provide health care and retirement benefits for staff member for YLM and San Pablo Lutheran Church for which they have 11 staff members.

Pastor Heimer would like to construct a 6 unit apartment complex on the property with 1-2 bedrooms in order to house persons for vicarage training as a means of creating a long term living quarters for ministry servants.

I was educated to this piece of ministry by way of Erin Mckenzie while in Santiago Dominican Republic. Erin has served on staff at YLM prior to her ministry in the DR and she told me that this piece of ministry does so much with so little.

My proposal is for the Southern Arizona Circuit to consider taking this beautiful piece of ministry as a long term commitment of support and ministerial Mission Participation.
