

Pastor Ron York brings us Peace Through the Word Live at our Facebook Page Monday-Saturday usually at 8:30 A.M.






Our sincere thanks to our brother Ron Warner for the gift of this beautiful offering receptacle he wood-crafted for us!


#### Charles L. Patterson

All Hymns are printed in the Bulletin. We do not yet pass the offering plates nor do we ask you to fill out attendance records. After Worship Service we exit from the back rows first working our way to the front rows.

Our cleaning service sanitizes each week and hand sanitizers are readily available in the Narthex and restrooms.


