


PITV HAPPENINGS NEWSLETTER October 2021



Pastor's Corner The Blessings of Reformation

Another month is turning the page on the calendar and we come to the month of October; fall in beautiful southern Arizona, Amen? With October comes Reformation Sunday, October 31st.

Reformation Day in huge in the Lutheran Church for on that day we celebrate Martin Luther reforming the Church from heretical teachings occurring within the Roman Church, but it goes much farther than that.

The word reformation is synonymous with dramatic or radical change, an alteration in the way people think, speak, and act. Just as there was a radical change within the Church, which gave rise to Lutheranism, there needs to be change in people today in their spiritual relationship with God through the person of Jesus Christ.

In the book of Leviticus, Chapter 26, beginning with verse 14, God is communicating through Moses punishments for being disobedient. On October 31, 2021, our celebration of the Reformation is our celebration of the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, for while we were still sinners Christ came and lived, died, and rose again for us, to give us the complete and total forgiveness sin, life eternal, victory over sin, death, and the Devil, along with a complete and restored creation: all of this without any merit from us at all, a true testimony to grace alone, through faith alone, by Christ alone. That is life transformational, which means life-changing. So as we look to October, may we rejoice in our gracious Lord, giving thanks for raising up Martin Luther as His herald of Divine Grace and Mercies to be bestowed on all people. *Pastor Ron*
