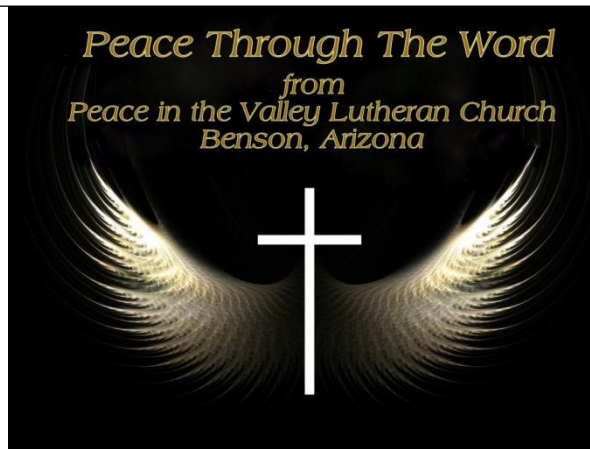

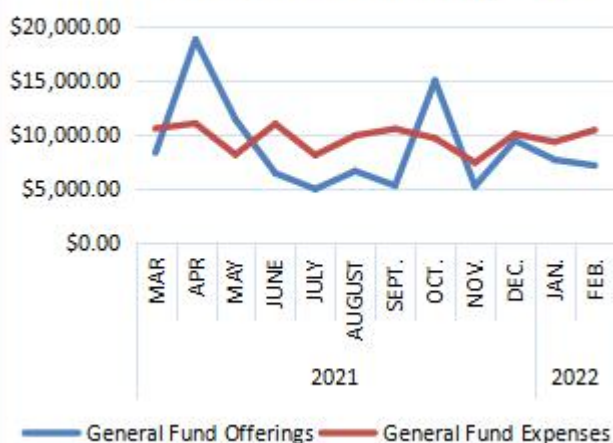

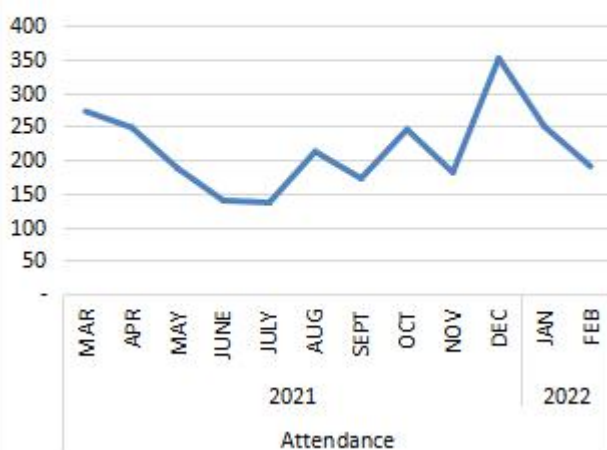

Pastor's Corner

Lent, The Church Year of Lent, is a time where the church sets aside a period of time in which we focus upon our sinfulness and what God in Jesus Christ had to do in order to remedy us from our sinfulness. It's during this time, as it should be all the time, but this time especially, to take sin and our individual sinfulness along with our willingness to sin very seriously. So in order to help us in that we are conducting mid-week Lenten Worship Services beginning on March 2, 2022, Ash Wednesday and proceeding through Holy Week of April 10th culminating on Easter Morning, Resurrection Sunday on April 17.

I therefore would really like to encourage all of us to take this time to prepare by way of looking at our individual thoughts and behaviors, being intentional in confession along with the reception of absolution while at the same time, being nourished throughout the weeks with Word and Sacrament Ministry.
