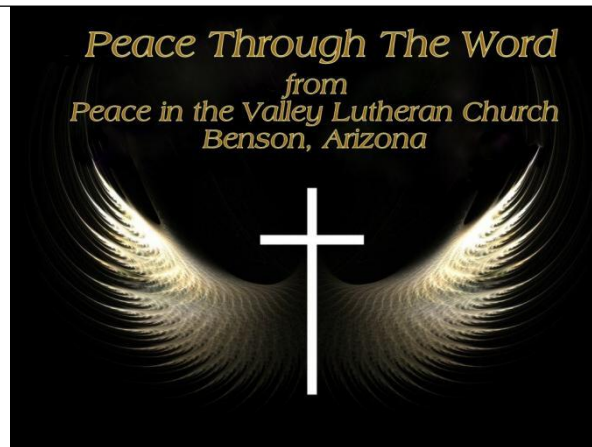

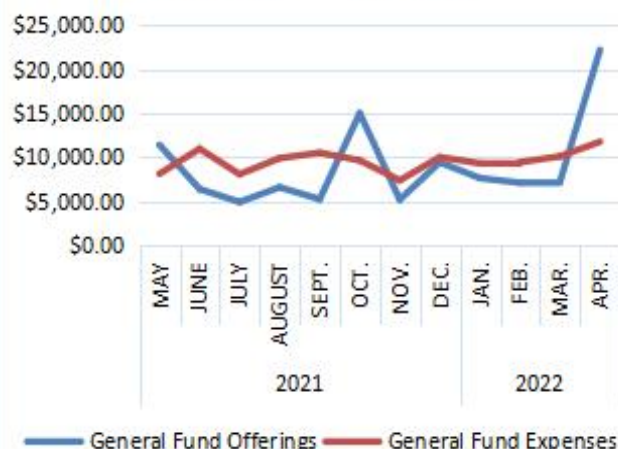
Attendance	1,050
