

It wasn't that many Sundays ago that we celebrated Good Shepherd Sunday. It seems that the reference to God as Shepherd and people as sheep is frequent in the scriptures.

In our Gospel for this morning people are described as sheep who are harassed and helpless. That is a common description of us "sheep" in the Bible. We as sheep are helpless, apt to stray, easily devoured by the enemy and ready for the slaughter. We as sheep are also described as those whom the shepherd loves and to whom he will allow no harm to come. So, at the same time we are God's little lambs and scattered-brained sheep.
