And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, 2 fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. Hebrews 12:1-2

When you sit in the sanctuary at Prince of Peace, how many crosses do you see? The most obvious one is in front on the wall directly over the altar, but there are many others – on the pulpit and lectern, the processional crucifix, on top of the Christian flagpole. There is at least one cross in each of the Bible Windows. There are many more.

The cross is the basic symbol of the Christian faith. All we are and all we believe have their foundation in the cross. Not that we worship the cross, but rather the One who was hung on a cross to redeem us from sin. Without Jesus' sacrifice on the cross, Christianity would be just one among the world's religions. But the mercy of God given on the cross sets the truth apart. This is why Paul writes, "For I resolved to know nothing while I was with you except Jesus Christ and him crucified." [I Corinthians 2:2]

The cross is an interesting shape. It is so simple – two plain lines meeting at right angles. A child can draw it. Even stylized renditions are recognizable as a cross. We can see crosses everywhere in life – from telephone poles to road crossing signs. Wherever a vertical line meets a horizontal line, we are reminded of God's mercy in Christ Jesus.

I have a collection of crosses – most are also a reminder of a relationship with a specific Christian brother or sister. But one of my favorite crosses at Prince of Peace often goes unnoticed. To be honest, it was not intended as a cross. I see it whenever I am facing the congregation, especially during services when I stand behind the altar. This large cross is formed by the balcony window and the support for the steeple. This cross, as all crosses, first reminds of the Savior. This cross, with its large bolts connected to the support beams, is an integral part of the building - holding it together. The cross reminds that Christ alone is the foundation, the connection, the support that holds His Church together. The Lord's Church, of course, is not the building. The Church is the people that God gathers and together receive His gifts and share in His ministry to others. His purpose was to create in himself one new humanity... through the cross... [Ephesians 2:15-16] The balcony cross reminds of this truth also is it sits above the congregation, reminding that Christ is Lord over His church.

The balcony cross also serves as a specific reminder as we once again prepare to celebrate Lent and journey with Jesus to the cross. Beyond the balcony cross is a window – emptiness – rather than a wall. Just as beyond the cross of Christ on Good Friday is the Empty Tomb of Easter. Even as we reflect in Lent, we celebrate (Sundays) the reality of today – we have a risen, living Lord. The further reality of the window is that beyond the cross is the world. Beyond the cross of Christ is the world to which we are called to share His love. When you sit in the sanctuary – before worship, during the offering, (even if your mind wanders as Pastor John is preaching...), look at the many crosses. Look at the world beyond. Know that the mercy of God through Jesus is for you. The love of God supports you and connects you to His Church. And you get to share His cross, His love with the world.
