And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. ²⁷ And I will put my Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to obey my rules. ²⁸ You shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers, and you shall be my people, and I will be your God. ²⁹ And I will deliver you from all your uncleanesses. Ezekiel 36:25-29

What is the farthest journey you have taken? Did you travel by car or airplane? Were you eager to get to your destination? Was the journey itself part of the purpose? Did you travel with others? Was there a leader on the journey? Did you have to stop and ask for directions?

Life is often described as a journey. We know where we have been, and we know the destination. We will pass through the gate and be welcomed home by our Heavenly Father. But what the journey holds on the way is not always clear. We may have traveling companions with us for days or decades. We stroll along under blue skies and hunker down under inclement weather. Our path is straight and well-lit at times and other times we face fog-enshrouded turns.

The season of Lent is also a journey. In our devotions and readings, we journey with Jesus. The journey is not always a straight line – of time or geography. We go from the Mount of Transfiguration – where Jesus is revealed in His glory. Along the way we journey with Jesus through His temptations in the wilderness, healing and teaching, rejection, and misunderstanding. Jesus' journey takes us to Jerusalem amid shouts of "Hosanna", and to the cross amid shouts of "Crucify Him."

The season of Lent is our journey. We begin with the stark reminder in ashes "dust you are and to dust you will return" [Genesis 3:19]. Along the way, the Holy Spirit guides in reflection and awareness as we, God's creation, examine our lives in the light of our Creator. Our journey is often uncomfortable as the need for the Savior is made plain.

Our Lenten journey does not end on the cross of Good Friday but continues to the empty tomb of Easter morning. Our reflection does not end with despair, but in hope – sure and certain hope. The message of Lent is the same as every day and season of the Church year – our God does not leave us to our own feeble devices, but God puts on flesh and lives among His creation – journeying with us – in order to take our sin to the cross and raise us to new life with Him. *God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.* [Romans 5:8] This why the 40 days of Lent do not include the Sundays. We are reminded each week (and every day) of God's mercy.

May God bless the journey of Lent as the Holy Spirit guides you in faith and hope – growing in clarity and truth and in the sure and certain promise of salvation in Jesus and the gift of the Resurrection.


OLD GLASSES and CASES [an LWML project]
