Why did Pilate come out to the Pharisees?
What is the irony? (Matthew 23:23-24)

What charge did the leaders bring against Jesus? What is the penalty? What charge was brought before Pilate? What is the penalty? God is in charge even of the method... John 18:32
Psalm 22:16 John 3:14,15 Deuteronomy 21:22-23

Jesus, the King – Is Jesus "King of the Jews"?

How does Pilate mean it? How is it true? How is it not?

"What is truth"?

A better question...?

Barabbas: "Son of the Father"

What does the name mean? How is it the ultimate irony?

Barabbas is the personification of Jesus' substitutionary atonement

Many people think they know (or direct) what is happening.

God knows and is in control.

What does God want you to know in the events of Chapter 18?

```
19:1-42 Jesus is crucified
```

Pilate proclaims Jesus' innocence (18:38, 19:4,6)

But has him flogged – why?

Why does God allow the flogging? (since God is in control...)

The charge – blasphemy and treason

Blasphemy against God (why should Pilate care?) 19:8

"Friend of Caesar" 19:12

Who is committing treason against their Lord?

19:10-11 Authority – who is in charge? Pilate does have authority, but...

John 19:19 – Another prophesy through an unbeliever

We know the events of the Crucifixion
