Future

Do you like to watch movies or shows? Do you imagine what it would be like to be one of the characters? Would you like to be "backstage" of your favorite show? What would it be like to stand next to the director as the story is being filmed? What if the director turned to you and asked you to get on the set and be part of the story? What if you discovered it's no longer a movie?

For the last couple of months, we have been talking about God's revelation of Himself to us and how we can know it's really God. (Read more in the June and July Proclaimer.) When we speak of knowing God, we recognize that the relationship always begins with God. We are helpless on our own. It is only by the work of the Holy Spirit that anyone can receive God's grace personally and respond in worship. The purpose of life is to grow in this relationship and to follow God's direction – to praise God as He gives opportunity.

How do we grow in relationship with God? Like any other relationship, it takes commitment and communication. This is one reason God gathers us together in Worship. We receive God's gifts—through His Word and Sacraments—and we respond to God's gifts in prayer and praise. There is much more happening (fellowship, teaching, etc.) but what about the other days of the week? How do you stay in communication with God (and growing in our relationship)? The basic communication is the same – God's Word and prayer. Through these gifts, your life is focused on God's gifts every day.

In daily relationship with God, your eyes are open to God's work. Through God's written Word (the Bible) you are reminded of God's gracious work all throughout history, you are given the wisdom God has given through the faithful before us, and you are given templates of praise and prayer. God's Word is Living and Active – the Holy Spirit works through the written and preserved Word to give and grow faith in you today. Christians respond to all these gifts in prayer. As in any relationship, one sided communication does not last long. God gives the gift of prayer – talking (or singing) to God. In prayer, we praise God, thank God, ask God, cry out to God, seek God, and grow in love and knowledge of God.

As your eyes are opened in relationship through the Word and prayer, you see God's hand in every part of life. You see God's hand in your past, in your family, in your community, and trust God for all things in the future. This is what it means

to know God's Story – as He has been at work throughout HIStory and in your life. As you grow in relationship with God, you see God's hand in your story. But God's Story is not a movie to sit and watch. God tells you to be part of the action. When you are in relationship with God and see His hand in your life, you also see His hand in the lives of those around you. And God calls you to help them see His work, His love, His mercy. You can share by giving an encouraging word, a listening ear, a helping hand – a pointing to the presence of God. Pray for the Holy Spirit to open your eyes to see His work – and to open your lips to share His Good News as His Story is happening all around you today.


