Psalm 122:1-5, 8-9

- ¹I rejoiced with those who said to me, "Let us go to the house of the Lord."
- ² Our feet are standing in your gates, Jerusalem.
- ³ Jerusalem is built like a city that is closely compacted together.
- ⁴That is where the tribes go up the tribes of the Lord—
- to praise the name of the Lord according to the statute given to Israel.
- ⁵There stand the thrones for judgment, the thrones of the house of David.
- ⁸ For the sake of my family and friends, I will say, "Peace be within you."
- ⁹ For the sake of the house of the Lord our God, I will seek your prosperity.

The book of Psalms is the hymnal of Israel. Throughout the Psalms (as with all the scriptures) we find ways to call on the Lord whether in distress or praise. Psalms 120-134 are "songs of ascent" sung as God's people "go up" to be in God's presence together. The Psalms of ascent are not lengthy because they go together.

Psalm 120 is a psalm of confession. We call out to God as we recognize the sin, distress, and strained relationships in our lives and those around us. We lay our sin before the Lord. We look for help as we live in a sinful world.

Psalm 121 recognizes our help. Our help does not come from within ourselves or from the idols of the world. We do not find peace by simply "following your heart" or counting on crystals, stars, drugs, or alcohol. When the psalms were written, people made idols on "the high places". Our help comes not from the "hills" of the world. Our help comes from the Lord – the Almighty Creator of all things (including ourselves). The Lord does not hide, but watches over His people constantly – day and night.

As God's dearly loved and protected people, we rejoice in His presence. In Psalm 122 we are gathered in the presence and protection and power of our help, the Lord -- the one who forgives our iniquity. You need rest from the weariness of life. You need comfort in the midst of life's challenges. You need to know the forgiveness of God – for you, your family, in all of your relationships. You need God's gifts as you are gathered with God's people -- not just once in a while, but always. As we prepare for the Holidays, it is a great time to return to the Lord in thanksgiving and celebration.

"Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness." Lamentations 3:22-23 "And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, 25 not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching." Hebrews 10:24-25

We go to the Lord in confession, receive Him who is our Help, and are gathered in praise.


