What is Sin? (How do you know?)

What is the difference between "sin" and "doing something bad"?

Original (hereditary) Sin / Actual (personal) sin

Psalm 51:5, Ephesians 2:3

Sin of omission / Sin of commission

All are equal in sin

Although the way sin is lived out may have different outward consequences, all are alike in sin Romans 3:9-20

At its root, sin is pride - looking to self instead of God

For good, reason, guidance, etc

Psalm 51:4

What is "Repentance"

Saying you're sorry?

Feeling sorrow for the consequences?

Doing something (penance)?

Telling a child to "say sorry" vs. helping a child to see the problem

Not on our own, but the work of the Holy Spirit through God's Word
