

"Why do you seek the living among the dead?" Luke 24:5

When I was in 1st Grade, I had an argument with my teacher. She said trees are alive and I insisted they are not. "Alive" in my mind meant breathing and moving – like animals and people. My teacher insisted that trees are living because they "breathe" in a different way (photosynthesis) and especially because they grow.

What do we mean when we proclaim "Jesus is alive"? Do we mean a metaphysical, symbolic, "spiritual resurrection" that defies explanation? No. We proclaim the simple truth: Jesus Christ -- true God and true man, born of Mary from Nazareth -- is alive. He died to take the punishment for our sin. And He was raised to life again -- true, full, body and soul life. He truly lives in His resurrected body. He breathes and eats (Luke 24:43) and will return to raise all people on the last day (I Corinthians 15:22).

What does it mean to you to be alive? Are you alive because you breathe and eat – because you go about daily tasks? Or are you living and moving and growing? You are given life and breath – not only taking oxygen (and other chemical compounds) into your body, but breathing in the very Breath of God, the Living Holy Spirit. (John 20:22)

How are you living today? How are you growing in the truth and knowledge, and love, and forgiveness of God? Sometimes Christians, rightly resting in God's gift of faith, forget that we are also called to grow. One of my favorite events in the scriptures is in Mark 9. Jesus (and Peter, James, and John) return from the Mount of Transfiguration to find the other disciples struggling to heal a demon-possessed boy. The boy's father pleads with Jesus, "If you can do anything, please help". Jesus replies "'If?' All things are possible for one who believes." The father cries out, "I believe. Help my unbelief!" In this father's profound plea, we see the truth of our life and faith. We who cling to Jesus – trusting Him for all life – we still harbor reservation and doubt. Our "old Adam" clings to us. So even (and especially) in faith, we must grow. Where does the growth of faith come from? The father does not say, "I believe, and I will keep growing in my belief." He pleads to the Lord "help my unbelief". Like all of us, he knows faith is not something we create, but a gift of God.

How and where does God give His gifts – that we may grow in faith? God's gifts are given by the Holy Spirit through the means He promises – His Word and Sacraments. God pours out life as He gathers us in worship, as we grow in His Word in devotions, Bible Study, and prayer. Together we grow in the love and gifts of the Holy Spirit. In the Crucified and Risen Christ, we have life abundant. (John 10:10) Together, we live today in the promise of eternal life. *"…Be rich in good works, to be generous and ready to share, thus storing up treasure for themselves as a good foundation for the future, so that they may take hold of that which is truly life.* I Timothy 6:18-19




