he awakens my ear




humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.




PALM SUNDAY / SUNDAY OF THE PASSION



P hope of everlasting life; through Jesus Christ, Your Son, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.


