Our Mission

At Little Lambs Learning Center, we believe that each child is a special and unique creation of God. And that is why our mission at Little Lambs Learning Center is to provide your child with a secure, loving Christian environment where he or she will develop spiritually, socially, emotionally, intellectually, physically, and creatively.

Our Vision

Guided by high expectations coupled with the knowledge that all God's children are created uniquely and learn at different levels and speeds, LLLC will provide students with a broad range of educational and fun opportunities that will help each child learn to the best of his or her abilities. We will strive to develop literacy skills as well as provide the best educational atmosphere opportunities within a Christian environment to create, have hands-on exploration, problem-solve, and have social interactions with peers.

Children will have a safe, wholesome, nurturing educational experience. Children will be in a loving Christian learning environment in which they can solve problems and express their feelings through words, art and other creative options. Children will be exposed to positive character lessons and experiences from the Bible and other literature, used to encourage each child to recognize his or her value in God's wonderful world He created.

Parents are an integral part of the educational process. In recognition of this important role, parent involvement is actively sought, encouraged and welcomed.

Our Programs

Two-Day Preschool program:

Students for the two-day class must be at least 3 years old before August 1. The two day program meets on Tuesdays and Thursdays. The class meets from 9:00am to 11:30am. Students must be toilet trained.

Three-Day Pre-Kindergarten program:

Students for the three-day class must be at least 4 years old before August 1. The three- day program meets on Mondays, Wednesday and Friday days. The class meets from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm. Students must be toilet trained.

Drop-Off: (8:45 am – 9:00 am)

Parents will walk child into classroom where you will be greeted by teacher and aide. This allows for smooth and consistent daily transition for both parent and child. When students enter the building, they are to put belongings into their cubby, answer question of the day and then may ease into social interaction with their peers during free play.

Pick up

Pick up time is organized to transition smoothly. Each child is accompanied to the vehicle to provide for maximum safety. The staff and parent are able to communicate important details at this time, and this time allows for smooth transition to each child into the next part of their day.

Classroom Size:

Preschool Class limited to 10. Pre-K classes limited to 16. There is a teacher and aid on staff at all times.

Tuition and Other Fees

Little Lambs Learning Center Tuition:

\$115.00 per month for two-day Pre-school

\$165.00 per month for three-day Pre-Kindergarten

\$70.00 Registration/material Fee

\$10.00 Late fee if tuition paid after the 10th of the month and an additional \$15 after 15th of the month.

Little Lambs' Goals

The goals of Little Lambs are met through a center based/discovery approach to learning. The program is both flexible and structured. This means that the curriculum is carefully planned around developmentally appropriate experiences, yet flexible enough to meet the individual needs of each child. God's love, creation and value are a very important base of what we learn every day. Each week we have a color, number, shape, and letter to learn about. Older classes will begin the foundations of emergent readers and writers. Each month we have a Bible verse and prayer to focus on. There will also be monthly homework assignments. These are designed to be fun and to help continue the learning experience outside the classroom for both the child and parent.

Parental Partnership and Involvement

A strong partnership between parents and Little Lambs is a critical component in your child's preschool experience. Parents are invited to provide feedback and to communicate actively with us. It is our duty to provide all student-related information and strategy in the best interest of each student. We place our trust in God to guide us as we look together at the preschool needs of each Little Lambs student.
