TRUSTEES will meet on Sundays, June 6th & July 11th (a week later due to Independence Day) at 12PM in the MPR. Many projects are in the works and planned for this year. Trustees are always looking for more help[®] Come to a meeting or speak with Stacy or A.J. Broviak about project needs.

BOILER LEAK: Among many other projects, the Trustee Committee is working on a permanent fix for the leaking underground boiler pipes in the east end of the church building which were discovered in April. The boiler is currently turned off. The east Education Wing was built in 1961 and composes of concrete block/brick construction with a flat roof. All of the plumbing was run underground and then inside the concrete block. This is our third underground leak since 2016. A local HVAC company has found a way to re-plumb the lines for the boiler but it will involve many visibly exposed water lines throughout the building due to the concrete slab foundation and flat roof. In addition, Redeemer still has one more underground water pipe which feeds the other half of the building (our fellowship room kitchen, two restrooms, and Sacristy). This pipe is the same age as the other failed pipes (*underground copper pipes have a 50-70 yr. life expectancy.*). **A motion passed** at the Congregational Assembly meeting held on Sunday, May 23rd to allow the Trustee Committee to explore the possibility of adding a pitched roof on the east end of the building, replacing the flat roof allowing space to move plumbing and HVAC to a second floor. *More detailed information is available in the Spring Congregational Assembly packet which can be found in the church foyer (table behind the green seating area).*

Christian Mundorf was raised in Saline, Michigan, by his parents George and Eleanor Mundorf. In Saline his parents took him to Christ Our King Lutheran Church where he was catechized and confirmed by Pastor Thomas Schroeder in 2011. Christian graduated from Saline High School in 2015 where he met his future wife, Abby Dester. After high school Christian went to Valparaiso University to study chemistry and the humanities and was a member of Christ College – The Honors College. 
