*From Pastor's Desk
August-September 2021*

“If the whole body were an eye, where would be the sense of hearing? If the whole body were an ear, where would be the sense of smell? ¹⁸ But as it is, God arranged the members in the body, each one of them, as he chose. ¹⁹ If all were a single member, where would the body be? ²⁰ As it is, there are many parts, yet one body.” – 1 Cor. 12:17-20

What does it mean to be part of the Body of Christ? What does it mean to be a member of a congregation? From the very beginning God has called His people together for worship as a single body of believers. If you read Redeemer's church constitution, you'll see this same focus. Redeemer exists to gather together for worship and the praise of Jesus, to grow in our faith through education and study, and to witness and bring the Gospel to the world around us. This is our singular goal and purpose, even while the mission of Redeemer is furthered by many individual members with their many and various gifts and offerings of their time, talents, and treasures. All the pieces and parts make up the whole body.

Almost all congregations have a membership that is more like a broken vase that's been superglued back together. There are pieces missing, there are lines that don't quite match up. And yet, it's still there, still holding together somehow, still beautiful in its own way. Most congregations have large swaths of their members who haven't been present for years, who have moved away, or have fallen into occasional or sometime attendance. Many congregations can't fill their positions of leadership or find people to serve on boards, committees, and teaching rosters. The year of quarantine has taken the already fractured vase of church membership and thrown it out the window.

Now we're picking up those pieces and trying to put it all back together again. What does church membership look like after quarantine? Who is coming back? Who isn't? Who is still watching online and waiting? Who has found another congregation and hasn't told us yet? Who has found us but hasn't joined us yet? All questions that we don't have answers to. But we know that it's hard to be a "whole" when you don't know where all the "pieces" are, and it will probably take quite a while for many congregations to feel all put together again, Redeemer included.

I am confident and thankful however, that the Lord is still watching over His Church, and He is still providing for our beautiful congregation. The Lord has sustained this Body of Christ in general health and security. The Holy Spirit has brought quite a few new members to our church. The Holy Spirit has inspired some of our members to take on new roles of service. Where we have lost leaders, God has raised up new ones. Where we have had needs, God has provided means that have often been more than adequate. When we have needed support, it has been there in abundance. When we have tried something new, it has been met with enthusiasm, grace, and encouragement. We don't have all the pieces just yet, like most congregations there are still things we're working on, but we're still holding together. Still beautiful. Still striving together. It's an exciting time for this body of Christ!

Find where you fit. That's my encouragement to you. Take the risk to lead or contribute in a new way. Maybe you're a hand or an ear. Maybe you're a voice in the hymn. A muscle moving chairs or painting walls. A heart, building ways to reach out to our homebound, or those who have needs they cannot meet themselves. Pray about it. Try different things. Be in worship. Come to a meeting. Find where you fit. Let's work together. Worship together. Rejoice together as one body in Christ.

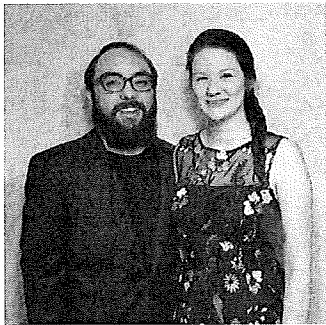

MEET REDEEMER'S 32ND VICAR CHRISTIAN MUNDORF AND WIFE ABBY



Christian Mundorf was raised in Saline, Michigan, by his parents George and Eleanor Mundorf. In Saline his parents took him to Christ Our King Lutheran Church where he was catechized and confirmed by Pastor Thomas Schroeder in 2011. Christian graduated from Saline High School in 2015 where he met his future wife, Abby Dester. After high school Christian went to Valparaiso University to study chemistry and the humanities and was a member of Christ College – The Honors College. While at Valpo, he also sang in the chapel choir, Kantori, and played in the handbell choir.

Each summer Christian spends around a month in Naknek, Alaska, with his family commercial fishing for sockeye salmon. In 2019 they caught about 95,000 pounds of salmon. Also in 2019, he began his studies at Concordia Theological Seminary and has particularly enjoyed studying the biblical languages, Greek and Hebrew, and church history.

In January 2021 Christian was married to Abby in their hometown at Christ Our King. Abby studied psychology and Spanish at Indiana University Southeast and is currently working towards her PhD in cognitive psychology at Michigan State University. Both Christian and Abby are excited come to Highland and meet the people of Redeemer Lutheran Church, and Christian cannot wait to be installed as vicar later this summer.


