From Pastor's Desk April-May 2022

"For we know that if the tent that is our earthly home is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens. ² For in this tent we groan, longing to put on our heavenly dwelling... so that what is mortal may be swallowed up by life..."

- 2 Corinthians 5:1-4

There was a house on the corner of Indianapolis Boulevard and Hart Road that I have admired as long as I've lived here. It wasn't a large house, but it appeared to be solid brick, a bit regal, standing there on a little hill, a defiant residence in the midst of all the business buildings and traffic around it. I wondered who lived there, if anyone, because every day that I drove past I never saw a single soul—but the grass was cut and the house was maintained. You could tell the house was loved by someone. It had been a place of life and memories, beautiful even as it aged.

Sometime in the fall, I noticed a construction fence put up around the property and the one next to it. A sign proudly declared that this beautiful brick house was going to be torn down to build a gas station and convenience store. With sadness, each day I drove past and saw the progress. Soon the house next door was torn down, and I expected the corner house to quickly follow. But it didn't.

The destruction crew were apparently using the brick house as a shelter and base of operations for cleaning up the rubble from the surrounding properties, and so the house began a much slower death. First what I thought was solid brick was stripped off and revealed to be just a façade. Then the windows were busted out, the front door removed. The winter wind whipped through the rooms, and the lacewhite curtains were pushed through the holes to wave at the traffic passing by. As Christmas neared, the house suffered a further indignity as someone painted "Merry X-Mas!" on the south side--a nice sentiment, but a tasteless execution. Then one day in the new year, the once beautiful home was finally put out of its misery, and it lay down in a pile of broken walls and dust. Soon, I'm sure, shiny new construction will begin, and the house will fade from the memory of most.

St. Paul likens our bodies to houses. Temporary houses—mere "tents." Like the brick house on the Boulevard, they can be beautiful, strong, regal even. On the outside at least. Over time however, sin and death take their toll. We require more maintenance. More repairs. Until one day, nothing more can be done to gussy up the place, and we collapse in the dust.

Jesus was in the dust. His body wrecked and disgusting. Jesus was as much in the grave as any of our loved ones are, as much as we will be also. But Jesus would not stay there. Life returned to Him. Flesh returned. Breath returned. Health and wholeness made His body glorious and perfect. Yet, Jesus kept His scars. Kept them for Thomas. Kept them for you. So that you would know that He is one in the same: the crucified One and the One who still lives. The dead One who is living still. The One whose body was placed into the dust but rose again in health and life forever.

As Jesus lives, so shall you. Easter proves that. We do not believe in a mere spiritual eternity, but rather we confess a bodily resurrection from the dead and a new heavens and new earth where we will live with our living Lord. That means the body that you have now, the very one dying even as we speak, will be made new and glorious by the same crucified hands that first formed it in your mother's womb. Jesus will raise you from the dead glorious like Himself, for "the perishable will put on the imperishable" (1 Cor. 15:53), and you will be more beautiful than any shiny new gas station.

Live in the confidence of the resurrection of the body and the life everlasting. A reflective Holy Week and a blessed Easter to you all!

Ascension Lutheran Christian School (ALCS), a relatively new Lutheran school in the Glen Park section of Gary, IN, is excited to announce that on Monday, April 18, 2022, Pastor Bryan Reeves, pastor of Immanuel Lutheran Church, Richton Park, IL, and his team will begin a 312-mile walk from Ascension in Gary, IN to St. Philip's Lutheran Church on the SE side of Cleveland, OH to raise much needed funds for the school.

The purpose of the walk is to raise awareness of ALCS, support its current operation, and provide funds to upgrade and expand the education opportunities and facilities.

"I want people to know about the good that is happening at Ascension," Pastor Reeves explained. "I want to get attention for Ascension. God is working in the hearts of our scholars and families to create something special in Gary. I believe we need to be ready to be part of the solutions when He calls."

A goal of Pastor Reeves' 312-mile walk for Ascension is a donation total of \$3.12 million. Many donors make this goal attainable, but whatever amount of money is raised will be worth the effort if people see Ascension School as a strong beacon of light in the Gary community.
