From the Pastor's Desk August-September 2022

"So then...you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, ²⁰ built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, ²¹ in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. ²² In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit."

— Ephesians 2:19-22

With the arrival of a new vicar and the start-up of many area schools, August and September always feel more like the beginning of a new year—much more than January 1st ever does. Redeemer is a teaching congregation, that is a big part of our identity. It's why we've committed our resources to training the vicars for service in the Church. It's why our Preschool and Sunday School are so important to our mission here. It's why our Bible classes are focused on the tough questions of life, and the deep meaning and difficult answers found in God's Word. Our artwork, our liturgy, our building, the things we do and the things we do not do, are all meant to teach something about what we believe. And that focus is resonating with the community around us. More than ever, new members to Redeemer have mentioned that they appreciate our focus on teaching the faith, and they often remark that there is so much to learn, and yet they are also excited to learn and grow into it. I can't think of higher praise.

God has blessed and provided for us a congregation that is not dying out or fading away. He has been building us together, new members and old, young and elderly, transfers and converts, for a long time now and that hasn't stopped in the last two years. I look around and see people taking up positions of leadership for the first time and I feel like a proud parent. The Holy Spirit is calling and gathering people together here, in this house of the Lord, and it is incredible to watch it happen before our eyes.

That does not mean that our congregation is without challenges. If there are areas that we can focus on I think they would be: 1) Growing in our understanding that weekly worship is an absolute must for the Christian faith. 2) Increasing religious instruction in the home and in families. 3) Caring for what God has given us and looking to provide for future generations of Redeemer members.

It is the third point that is the most tangible challenge. We are probably on the cusp of a major building/repair project for the East wing and the replacement of some HVAC systems. We may begin these projects only to discover that even more extensive repairs are necessary. Concerns about inflation and the cost of materials has everyone saying now is not the time to build if you can avoid it. Congregations without debt, like Redeemer, generally don't want to go into debt. All these things make sense. But God's timing doesn't always make sense to us. Sometimes we just have to do what needs to be done, and trust that God will see us through.

Of course the Bible teaches us that God does see His people through difficult times. Our own history at Redeemer teaches us the same. Redeemer has been built/renovated/rebuilt several times in our history, those saints didn't know the future any more than we do. The Lord has provided. He will do so still. As much as I am concerned about the needs facing our house of God, I'm confident in the Lord's provision and excited to see where the Lord will have us go. And I am thankful that we are a house built on Christ and built together with all of you. The Lord has given us so many blessings in the skills and talents of Redeemer's members, the support and prayers of so many, and the faith that has inhabited this building for over 60 years. I think there is much more yet to come. May Jesus always guide us.



MEET REDEEMER'S 33RD VICAR Addison Pope

Addison Pope grew up in the suburbs and small towns around Toledo, Ohio. He was born in July of 1994 and baptized a few months later. Addison was baptized and catechized in a congregation of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA) in Perrysburg, a suburb of Toledo. After graduating high school Addison attended the University of Findlay in Findlay, Ohio, where he earned a BA in history. While he was in college, he began taking Christianity seriously and started to study theology. Through much study and contemplation, the Holy Spirit led him to confessional Lutheranism and he began attending the local LCMS church: Concordia Lutheran in Findlay. While studying at Findlay, he also met his wife, Madelaine. They were both part of a reading group that read the works of J.R.R. Tolkien and C.S. Lewis aloud. Addison and Madelaine were married soon after they graduated in June of 2017. The Popes then moved to Bowling Green, Ohio so that Madelaine could pursue a master's degree in literature at Bowling Green State University. While living in

Bowling Green, Addison worked as a security officer at a Chrysler factory in Perrysburg. This job gave him a lot of time to think, and he began talking to his pastor about going to seminary. After Madelaine earned her Master's degree in 2019 the two moved to Winchester, Kentucky. Addison worked as a security officer for the University of Kentucky (UK) hospital system while Madelaine taught at UK. While in Kentucky, Addison and Madelaine welcomed William Lewis Pope into the world in June of 2020. That fall, the family moved to Fort Wayne so that Addison could attend seminary, and he has been studying hard ever since. Madelaine has a teaching job at Indiana Tech, which she will be continuing by teaching online writing classes next year while Addison is serving as a vicar. When he is not studying Addison enjoys hunting, fishing, gardening, and taking family nature walks with his American Bulldog, Ophelia. Madelaine enjoys reading Victorian fiction and hiking. William loves playing with toy trucks and singing out of Addison's hymnal.

Vicar Addison Pope will be installed at the 8 A.M. Service on Sunday, August 7, 2022.
