From the Vicar's Desk

February/March 2023

"Praise the Lord, all nations! Extol Him, all peoples! For great is His steadfast love toward us, and the faithfulness of the Lord endures forever. Ascribe to the Lord the glory due His name; bring an offering, and come into His courts." – Ps. 117:1-2a; 96:8

In Epiphany we celebrate the beginning of Jesus' ministry and the coming of His light to nations that once had sat in darkness. This time of late winter is a fitting time to ponder these things, as the darkest days of the year are behind us. Now the days grow gradually longer, and even though it feels a long way away, we know that the warmth of spring is coming not too far away. We hear about the beginning of Jesus' ministry in the city of Capernaum in the region of Galilee, a region known for its mixture of Jews and Gentiles. Prior to Jesus, God's promises were given only to those who were descended from Abraham. Yet God also promised to send a Messiah, who would teach the Gentile nations about Himself and incorporate them into His Kingdom. Jesus was this Messiah, who came to the people who dwelled in the darkness and brought them into His light. Jesus was born in a little backwater town in Palestine about 2,000 years ago. If we look at His origins from a purely human perspective, as His contemporaries did, we wouldn't think much of Him. Yet we know that He is God Himself - through Him all nations are drawn to God, and people from all nations are given His wonderful gifts. Jesus was born to Mary, who was descended from King David and Abraham, but He became the Way, the Truth, and the Life not just for the Jews, but for the Gentiles as well. Through Christ the Gentile nations that were not of Abraham's line were fully incorporated into God's Kingdom.

God's plan of salvation, promised to Adam and Eve after the Fall into sin, became a full reality in Jesus. He came to bind up the wounds of all mankind, to heal the division between us and the Almighty Judge

by giving us forgiveness for our sins. All nations of the earth can now praise the Lord for His steadfast love. Jesus has shown the nations that God is faithful: by dying for us and taking away our sin, we see that our God is merciful and loving, and desires to be near us. He gives us these gifts out of His love, without any merit or worthiness on our part. This is why the nations can praise God – on the cross He shows us His steadfast love for us and saves us from death and sin.

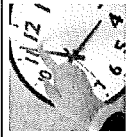

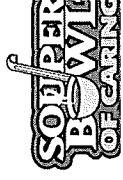

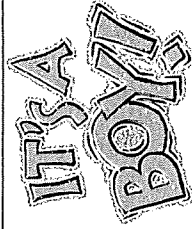

BUILDING COMMITTEE UPDATE ON EAST WING:

The Building Committee met with three Design Build Companies in August 2022. The committee unanimously chose PBS Design Build to work with on the rebuilding project. PBS Design Build sent Redeemer a contract for the Pre-Construction Phase for \$23,470 which will include Project Financial Analysis; Facility Needs Analysis & Planning; Site Challenge Analysis; Facility/Site Conceptual Design; and Scope & Budget Development which will give us drawings and a project cost to bring to a Special Congregational Assembly.

A grant application was submitted by Elizabeth Hecimovich (Building Committee Chair) to the Center for Congregations. The Center for Congregations awarded Redeemer a Resource Grant in January to cover 50% of the Pre-Construction Agreement with PBS Design Build (\$11,735). The contract will be signed with PBS Design Build on February 1, 2023, which was approved at the November 20, 2022 Fall Congregational Assembly.

Next steps will be for PBS to recreate the existing site and building (will take a week or so); check the created plan against the current site condition; and then the Building Committee will meet with their design team.



