Men

Elders:

Elders consist of seven or more men nominated by the senior pastor and approved by the M&M Council and the current Board of Elders. They assist the pastors as requested in specific functions such as administration of the sacraments, and matters of church discipline. They also see that the pastors and church workers are supported and cared for according to Holy Scripture. Training is provided. Individuals interested in serving should contact the senior pastor by calling 425-6071

Chairperson or Vice Chairperson of the Congregation:

The Chairman and Vice Chairman are elected by the Voters' Assembly. In the LCMS, these positions are held by male members of the church. Each position has a two year term and individuals may serve no more than two full successive terms in that position without a break of at least one year. Specific duties are outlined in the Constitution. Elections are held in May of each year. Individuals interested in serving should notify the church office, or submit a volunteer form. 
