Dear Members of Redeemer,

The leaders of Redeemer met on Sunday, July 5, 2020 to discuss changes incident to the Corona (COVID-19) virus. We are excited to announce we will be going back to two (2) worship services again (8:30 and 11:00) on Sunday, August 2, 2020. Narthex doors will not be unlocked until 8:00 am and 10:30 am (30 minutes before service begins).

In an effort to help protect the health of our members and be good stewards for our community, we will follow the guidelines established by the Governor's office for Houses of Worship. Therefore, we will continue to practice social distancing by maintaining a physical distance of six (6) feet (except families) and masks will be worn by everyone. If you do not have a mask one will be provided before you enter the Narthex along with hand sanitizer. The only doors that will be unlocked will be the Narthex doors. Everyone must enter through the Narthex doors. The fellowship hall and administration office area will be closed. There will be no refreshments served, Sunday School or adult bible study at this time.

If you do not feel well, have a fever, cough, compromised immune system or are the caregiver of such, please stay at home. The church will remain closed during the week. As before, church staff will be available to answer phone calls during office hours while the church is closed.

In addition, if you are unable to make it on Sunday or are nervous about the number of people in the Sanctuary, we will start providing communion on the 1st & 3rd Wednesdays of the month from 9:00 am to 12:00 noon. You must call the church office to schedule an appointment for communion during that time.

Church leadership will continue to meet to discuss updates to the guidelines. Additional communications will be provided as changes occur. Thank you all for your cooperation during this difficult and fluid time.

Please continue to pray for our church, state, nation and those affected by the Coronavirus.
