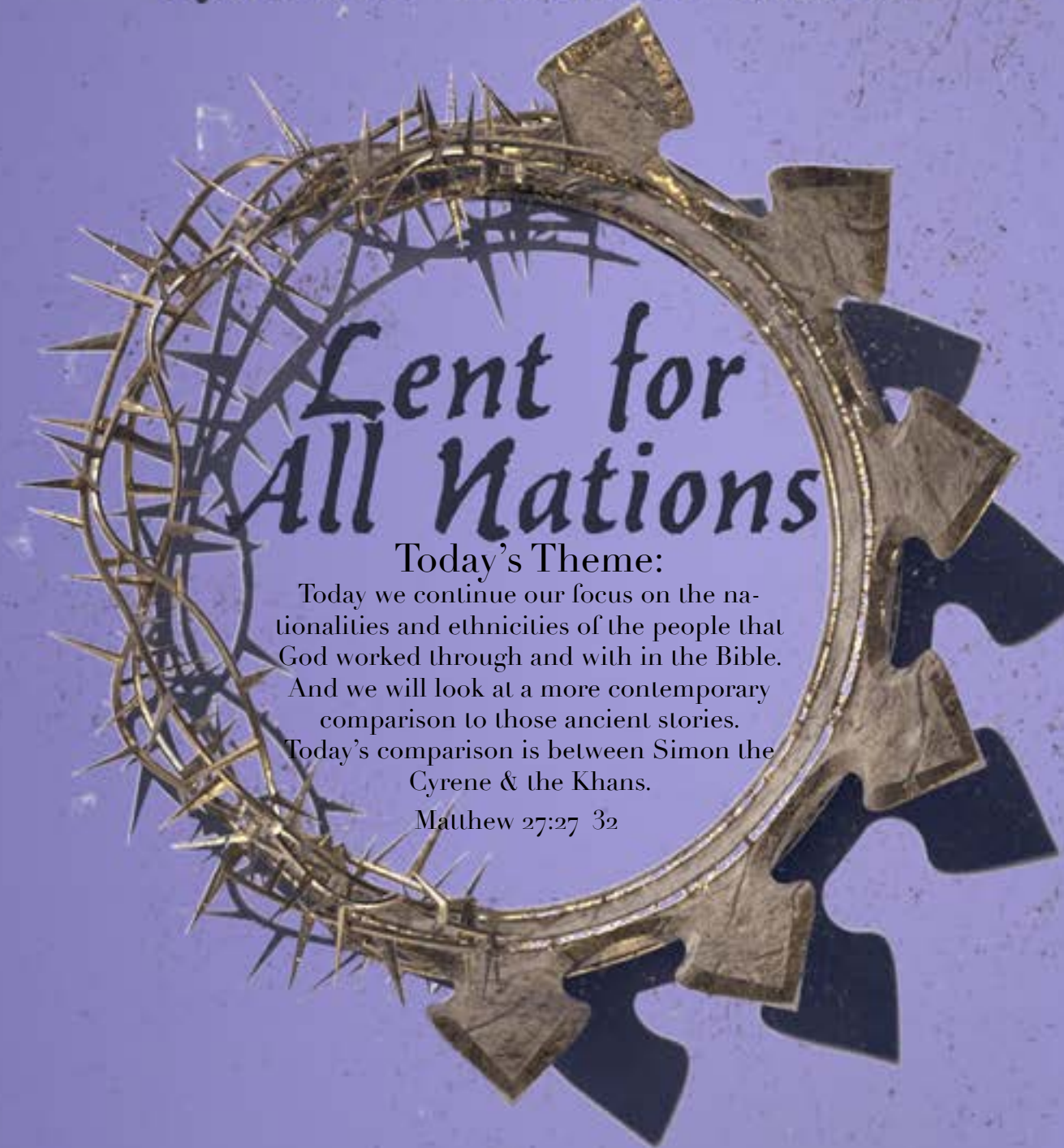
Stewardship
