Now I’m going to make a distinction here. Jesus is not talking about being “tired.” You know tired, the bodily exhaustion. He’s making an invitation to those who are weary. Weariness is a condition of the heart, the conscience, and the soul. Weariness comes to most of us through worry. And Jesus is promising to take our worry, put it into perspective, and give us rest.

PRAYER: Dear Lord, pains and problems are part and parcel of life in this sinful world. I give thanks for the Redeemer who has rescued my soul for eternity. May I also rejoice in His ongoing companionship which helps with the living of each day. In Jesus’ Name I ask it. Amen.
