Redeemer Lutheran Church is fully committed to meeting the needs of families with young children in our neighborhood.

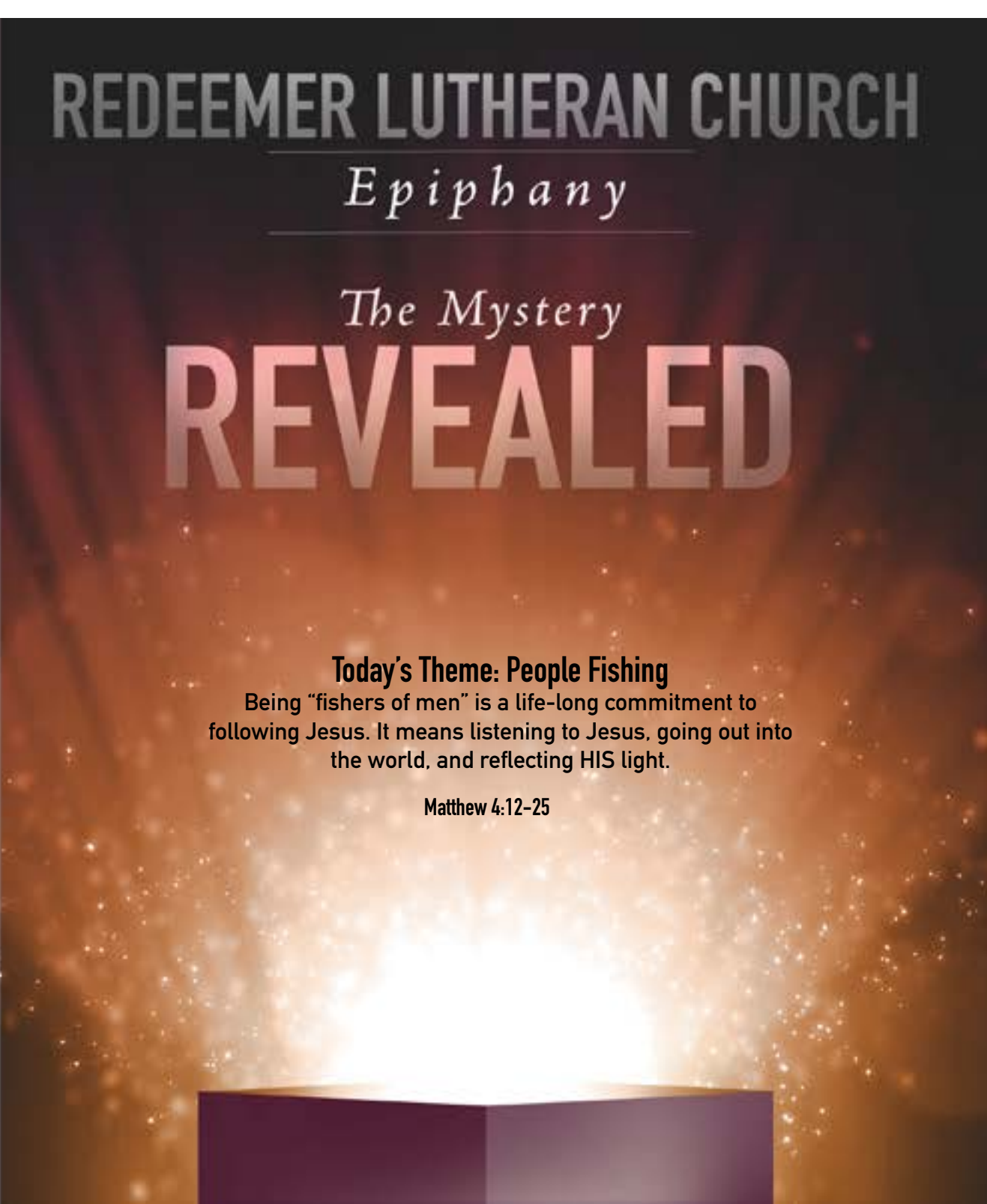
